- On 25 May 2010, the 190th Session of the ICAO Council approved the establishment of the following RASGs:
 - RASG-PA, RASG-EUR, RASG-APAC, RASG-AFI and
 - **RASG-MID**

To support a regional performance framework for the management of safety






RASG-MID

Eestablished following the ICAO Council directive and the agreement of the DGCA-MID/1meeting (UAE, March 2011)

- Regional implementation of the GASP and establishment of the regional safety priorities and targets
- A collaborative and coordinated approach in partnership with all aviation stakeholders under the leadership of ICAO (coordinated and joint activities, resource sharing,..)
- Support collection of data
- Development/implementation of Safety Enhancement Initiatives (SEIs) and Detailed Implementation
 Plans (DIPs)
 - Mitigating risks of the regional main killers and emerging risks
 - Supporting the implementation of SSP/SMS, States' Safety Oversight capabilities, Accident & Incident Investigation, ELP, etc.

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RASG-MID DELIVERABLES

- Five MID Annual Safety Reports
- MID Region Safety Strategy (safety priorities, indicators and targets)
- Doha Declaration (High level priorities and targets)
- The MID NCLB Strategy/Plan (specific plan of action for each State according to an agreed prioritization criteria and other factors- involvement of all Stakeholders)
- Three MID Region Safety Summits
- Safety Management Workshops
- Establishment of the MENA-RSOO (will be hosted and supported by Saudi Arabia)
- Various RASG-MID Safety Advisories (RSAs)
- MID Regional Runway Safety Seminar, Aerodrome Certification Workshop and Runway Safety Team (RST) Workshop and several Runway Safety Go-Team
- Studies/Surveys (Call Sign Confusion, Laser Attacks, etc.)














States above 60% EI
