Establish AIG Cooperation working group (WG)

- Define participating states;
- Representative from each participating state;
 - ➢ Officially nominated by the state
 - Commit to participate in all WG activities
- F Elect Chair and Vice Chair;
- Representation Agree on terms of reference;
- Meet as frequent as necessary to achieve objectives
- Document all activities







WG Objectives

- For Define specific areas of cooperation and protocols of engagement;
- Draft cooperation policy including handling of associated cost;
- Draft procedures and necessary mechanisms;
- Define areas of required facilitation within participating states;
- Draft multilateral MOA to assure commitment;
- MOA signature

AIG Cooperation Organization

- Represented by each member states;
- Chairmanship rotated amongst member states every 2 years;
- Meet bi-annually;
- Monitor implementation of the cooperation policy and procedures and ensure its effectiveness;
- For Prepare annual cooperation report and disseminate to member states;
- Member states cover the cost of participation of their respective representative.
