Introduction and Overview

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The NCLB initiative

- The ICAO No Country Left Behind (NCLB) initiative, was launched in December 2014, aims at providing support to all States and in support of the five ICAO strategic objectives, for the resolution of significant safety concerns (SSCs) and significant security concerns (SSeCs) and for an effective implementation of ICAO's SARPs, policies, plans and programmes, in a globally-harmonized manner; promoting and implementing all ICAO's assistance activities.





NCLB Initiative

- The NCLB initiative seeks to improve implementation support delivery to States.
- Support, collaboration and assistance from States, international organizations, industry and other stakeholders is essential to the success of these ICAO efforts to ensure that no Country is left behind





Introduction

- The ICAO MID Regional Office promotes and monitors the implementation of Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) in 15 Member States of ICAO to which it is accredited.
- The MID Region is faced with a wide variety of geopolitical diversity, airspace features, operational challenges and civil aviation capacity building issues.

- **Why we are here?**
- According to the USOAP CMA Reports, between 2014 and 2016, the audit process detected 5 critical issues at Aerodromes:
 - ✓ Implementation of requirements for aerodrome certification
 - ✓ Ensure that an AO receiving international flights has an SMS acceptable to the State
 - ✓ Certified Aerodrome Surveillance
 - ✓ Implementing Track Safety Measures
 - ✓ Aerodrome data quality system

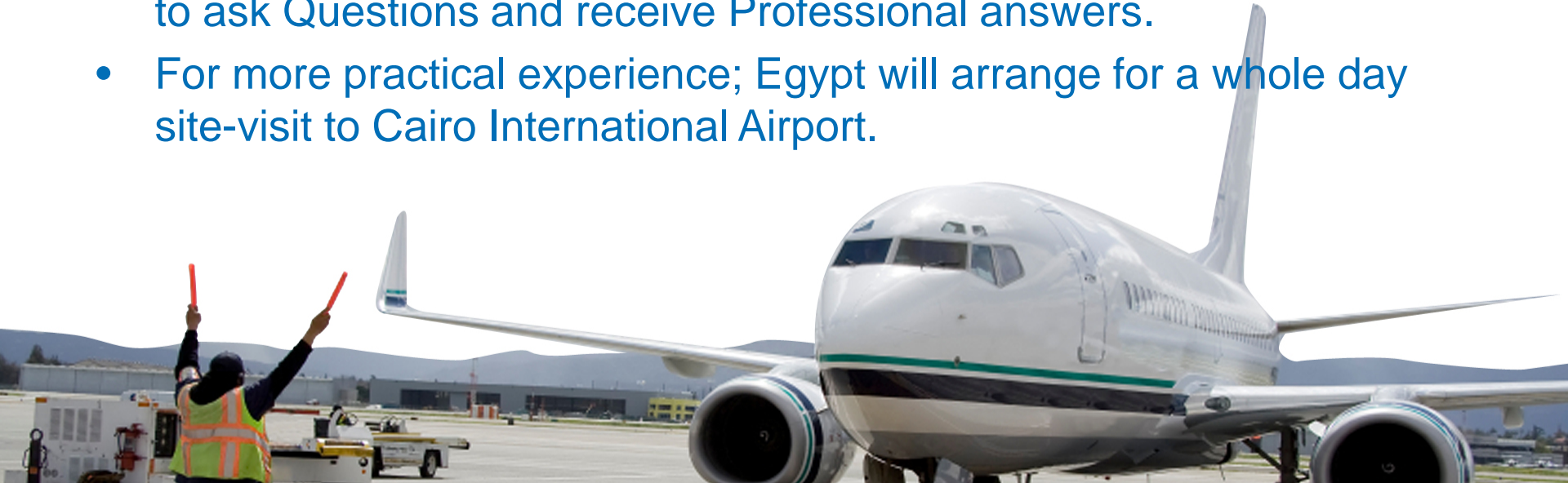
- As part of their technical Support to the NCLB initiative Egypt and UAE will exchange their best practices and experience on Certification Challenges and lesson learned with the Participants
