- The Health Office services in the airport started in 1952 by Dr. P. P. Mathews, who was on call attending the emergency cases in the health office followed by Dr. Ramzy Faiz and Dr. Mustafa
- At present, the Airport Clinic is operated by the Ministry of Health and is located at the departure area (level6.0) opposite to gate12B

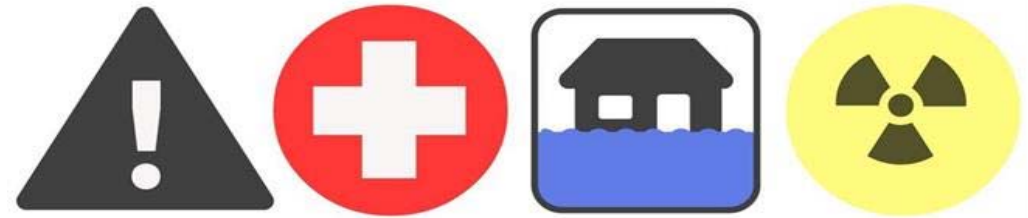

Nipah Virus

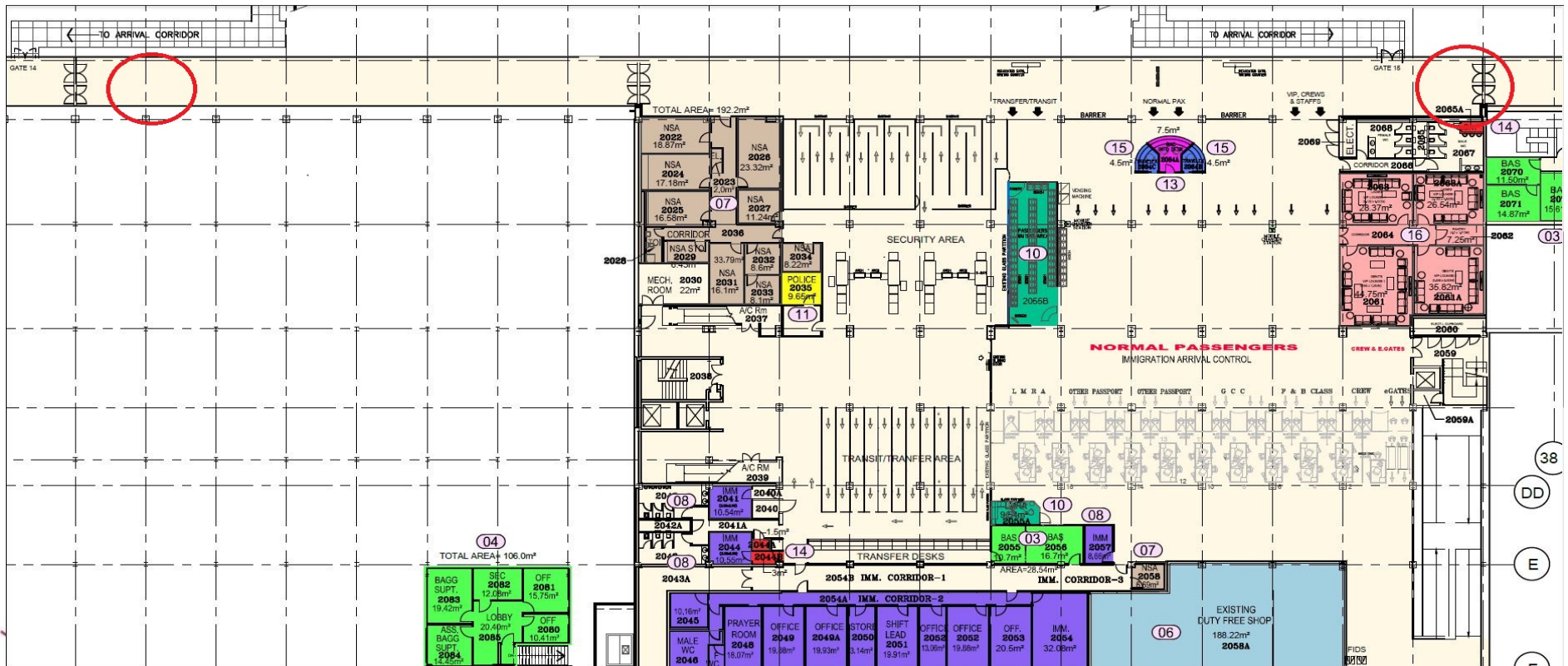
- Close coordination took place between the Airport Clinic & the Public Health Directorate – MoH
- Additional medical team was available on duty 24/7 to handle & treat all flights arriving from an infected destination
- Thermal Scanners were installed at arrival (L2.8) as there was a spread of Nipah Virus (Pandemic Influenza)
- Manual Nipah temperature screening took place at Gate 12B to ensure each passenger arriving from an infected destination was examined.
