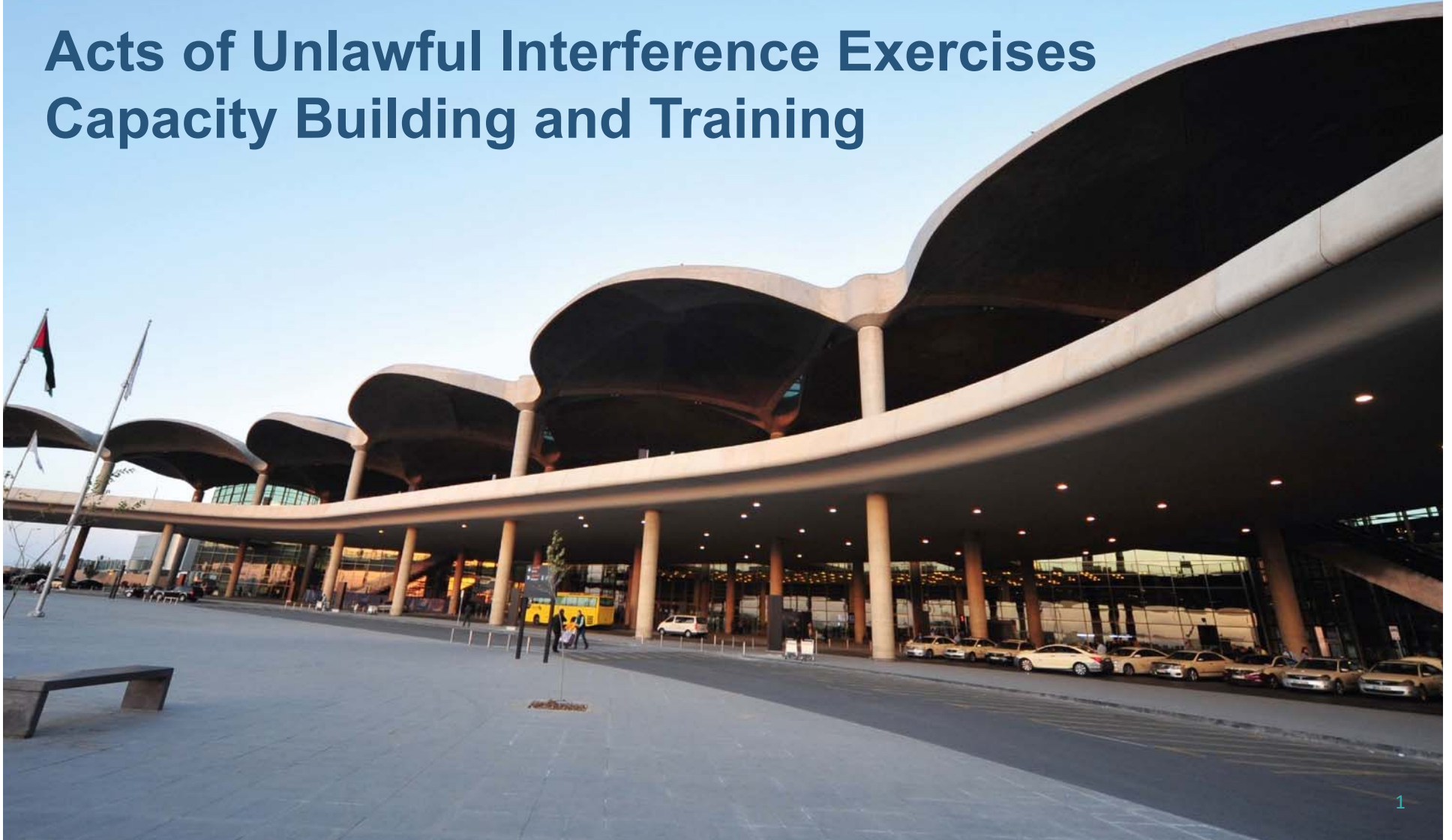


# Acts of Unlawful Interference Exercises Capacity Building and Training



## MANAGEMENT OF RESPONSE TO ACTS OF UNLAWFUL INTERFERENCE

**5.1.4** Each Contracting State shall ensure that contingency plans are developed and resources made available to safeguard civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference. The contingency plans shall be tested on a regular basis.

**5.1.5** Each Contracting State shall ensure that authorized and suitably trained personnel are readily available for deployment at its airports serving civil aviation to assist in dealing with suspected, or actual, cases of unlawful interference with civil aviation.

## 11.10.8 Contingency plans

Airport Operators, Air Courier, Regulated Agents and Air traffic Controllers shall prepare contingency plans to ensure required measures are taken in case of the presence of acts of unlawful interference, security incidents, security breach, of economical conflict that might have an effect of aviation security.

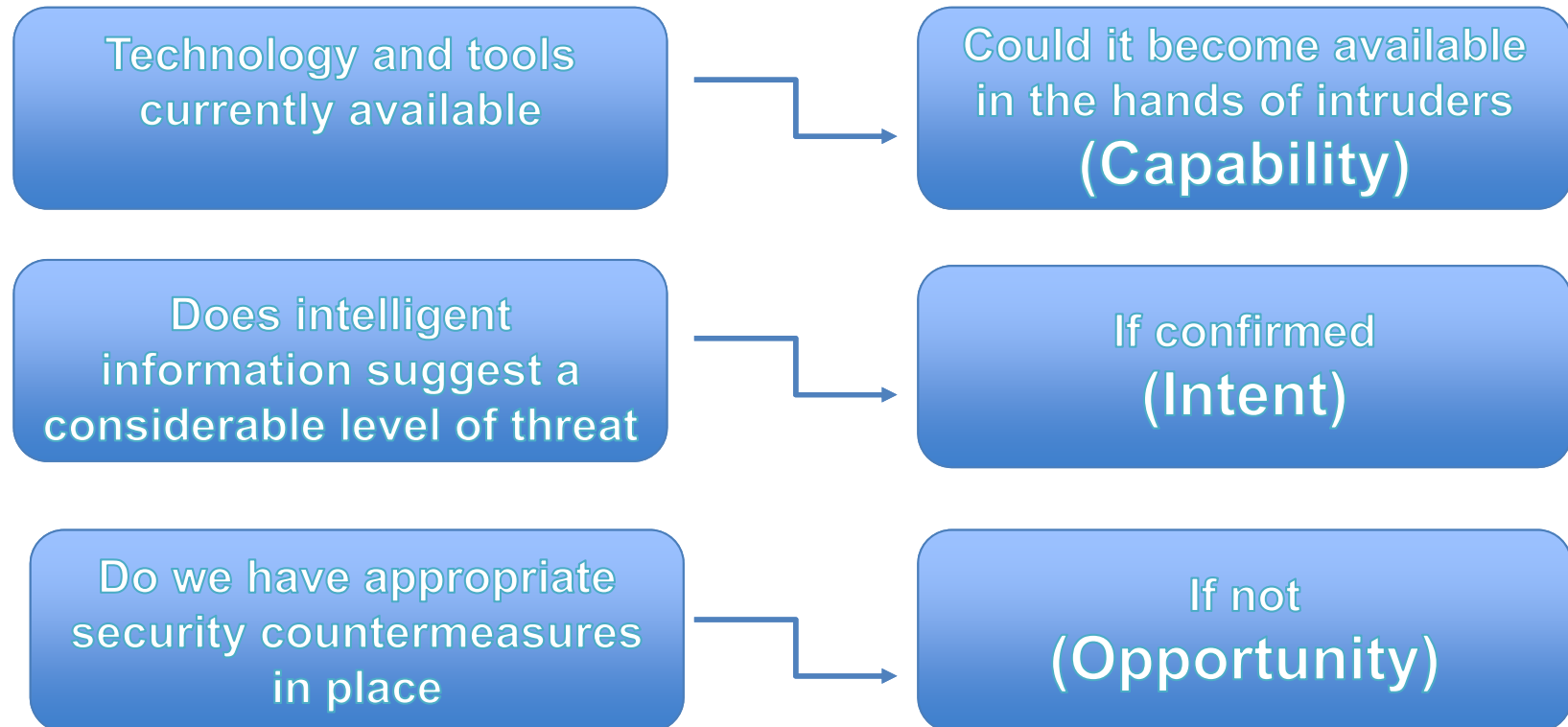
**11.11** testing contingency plans has to be conducted on regular bases through exercises, and reviewing the results to evaluate the efficiency and consider enhancement of these plans.
