#### **1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 The Provisional Agenda for the Fifth Meeting of the Air Traffic Management Sub-Group (ATM SG/5) at **Appendix A** was forwarded to States and Organizations concerned, as an attachment to the Invitation Letter Ref. ME 3/2.1 & AN 6/33.1 dated 14 October 2019.

1.2 Reference is made to the MIDANPIRG Procedural Handbook, Seven Edition – December 2013, Part IV, Section 6, *Officers and Secretariat of Sub-Groups of the MIDANPIRG*:

2.1 The meeting may wish to recall that in accordance with the MIDANPIRG Procedural Handbook (MID Doc 001), Part III, para. 6.1, Mr. Saleem Mohamed Hassan, Director Air Traffic Management, Civil Aviation Affairs, Bahrain, was unanimously re-elected as Chairperson of the ATM Sub-Group for three additional meetings.
