

# ICAO and the United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy



• Counter-Terrorism Implementation Task Force (CTITF) established by the UN Secretary-General in 2005.

• Mandate: strengthen coordination and coherence of counter-terrorism efforts of the UN) system to avoid duplication of efforts, and improve accountability.

• CTITF consists of 38 international entities including CTED and ICAO, each of them contributing to the multilateral counter-terrorism efforts consistently with its own mandate.

# Main Outcomes from A40

- ↗ Endorsement of the ICAO Cybersecurity strategy for the air transport sector
- Endorsement of ICAO's expeditious delivery of the Global Aviation Security Plan (GASeP)
- ↗ Support for the progress made in the implementation of the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa (AFI SECFAL)
- Endorsement of continued addressing by ICAO of the recommendations that emerged from the Second High-level Conference on Aviation Security convened in 2018

# Strategic AVSEC priorities (2020-2022)

- Continued attention to be placed on:
  - implementing HLCAS/2 recommendations fully
  - undertaking work focused on the tenets of UNSCR 2309
- Revise GASeP as necessary based on triennial revision schedule
- ↗ Implement three Resolutions adopted at 40th Assembly:
  - Resolution A40-10 on Addressing Cybersecurity in Civil Aviation
  - Resolution A40-11 on the Consolidated statement on continuing ICAO policies related to aviation security
  - Resolution A40-12 on Affirming Global Commitment to Strengthening Implementation (Declaration on Aviation Security)





# **Key outcomes of AVSECP/30**

- Current threats and risks to civil aviation:
  - Risk posed by PBIEDs, the insider threat, RPAS and threats posed by chemical agents
  - Reporting of acts of unlawful interference (AUI) to ICAO
- Produced draft Amendment 17 to Annex 17
- ↗ Endorsed new/updated guidance:
  - 11th Edition of Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973)
  - Second edition of the Global Aviation Security Risk Context Statement (Doc 10108)
- Review of the USAP-CMA methodology

# **Global Aviation Security Plan (GASeP)**

- GASeP approved by ICAO Council in November 2017
- MID Regional Roadmap updated and approved in 2018
- Regional results indicate 10 of 13 USAP-audited MID States (77%) are above 65%
  - Global aspirational target is 80% for 2020
  - Shortfalls noted in CE7, Quality Control, and CE8, resolution of security concerns next slide shows overall results
  - Target for 2023 is much more aggressive: 90% of States above 80%
- ICAO Secretariat has established a secure portal group to assist with understanding and fulfilling GASeP actions and tasks; Regional Officers have access to information
- Triennial revision cycle approved by 40th Session of the ICAO Assembly; 2020-2022 version will reflect updates to Roadmap but no changes to targets or Priority Outcomes



#### USAP Audit Results for MID Region as at 30 September 2019





# ICAO's work on cybersecurity

- Assembly Resolution A39-19 instructed ICAO to develop a comprehensive cybersecurity work plan and governance structure;
- Secretariat Study Group on Cybersecurity (SSGC) developed the Cybersecurity Strategy endorsed by the ICAO 40th Assembly;
- The SSGC is currently working on the implementation plan of the Cybersecurity Strategy.





## ICAO's work on cybersecurity: Next Steps

- States and Industry to <u>implement</u> the <u>Cybersecurity Strategy;</u>
- States to adopt and implement the Beijing 2010 Convention and Protocol;
- ICAO to analyse and develop a <u>future structure for the cybersecurity work</u> programme that will ensure issues are addressed in a cross-functional manner across all Bureaus of ICAO;
- SSGC to finalize the Cybersecurity Implementation Plan;
- ↗ ICAO to launch the <u>Cybersecurity Repository</u> and <u>Point of Contact</u> network.

# **No Country Left Behind Objectives**

- More effective support to ALL willing States that need assistance to develop and improve the aviation system by implementing ICAO policies and provisions in all Strategic Objectives
  - For SARPs implementation
  - To raise States to 60% EI in safety/security or for States with low EIs
  - For States which have local challenges where ICAO can help
- Convince those States that are unwilling
- Assist those States which are willing but unable to progress alone
- Collaborate and pool resources with partners and donors





# **ICAO Aviation Security Assistance**

- ↗ Assist States to comply with Annex 17 Security
- Following an ICAO USAP audit, a State's specific request, or a priority evaluation
- ↗ State's commitment to improve their AVSEC capabilities
- ↗ Use of ICAO Aviation Security Improvement Plan (ASIP)
- The Enhance aviation security oversight system and sustainability
- Collaborate with Regional Officers and experts in Regions

# **Aviation Security Improvement Plan (ASIP)**

- Short to mid-term multi-phased framework for State capacity building
- Based upon a needs assessment and tailored assistance requirements
- ↗ Following a USAP audit or at a State's specific request
- Commitment of the State to improve their AVSEC capabilities
- Developed collaboratively with the appropriate State authority responsible for aviation security, and with stakeholders
- Structured package of activities with monitoring of results





# **ICAO AVSEC Training: Highlight Achievements**

- In 2018, there were a total of 42 ICAO-sponsored courses and workshops (arranged directly by ICAO HQ) conducted through the ASTC Network, with 646 aviation security specialists from a total of 107 Member States having benefitted from training.
- As of 30 Sep 2019, there were a total of 23 ICAO-sponsored courses and workshops conducted in 2019 through the ASTC Network, with 343 aviation security specialists from a total of 76 Member States having benefitted from training.
- Additionally, many more courses and workshops are conducted on a weekly basis by ICAO Regional Offices and other ICAO Programmes (e.g. CASPs) in coordination with ICAO HQ.
