CORSIA eligible emissions units

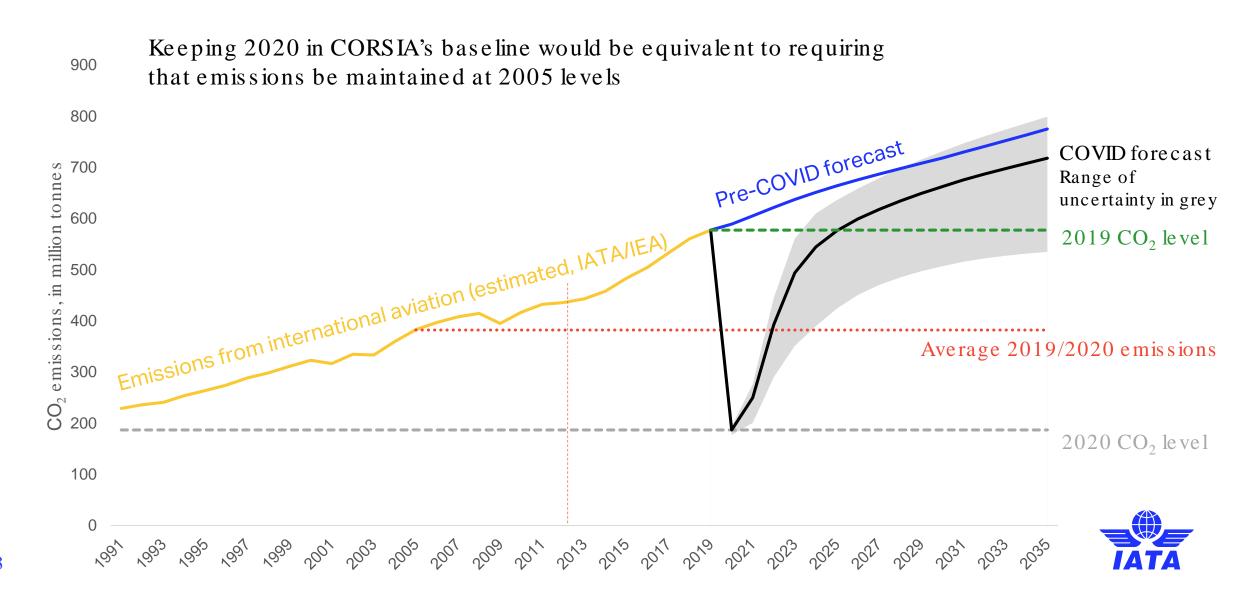


Global Carbon Council (GCC)

Emissions from international aviation fell below 200 MtCO₂

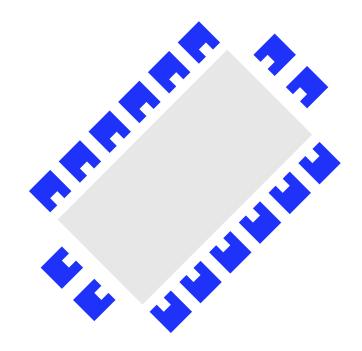


2020 Council decision on CORSIA baseline

Actual 2020 emissions should not be used for any CORSIA design features

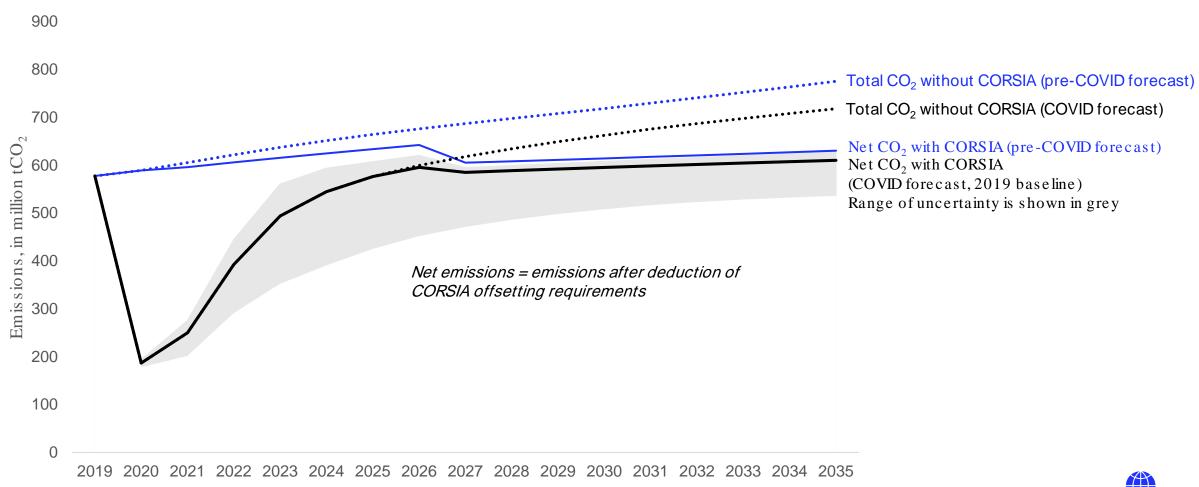
During the pilot phase, 2019 emissions will be used instead of 2020 emissions for CORSIA's baseline and other design elements

The Council will consider amendments to Assembly Resolution A40-19 to also use only 2019 emissions beyond the pilot phase. The amendments will be presented to the 41st session of the Assembly for decision

Regional Challenges

- Lack of clarity on CORSIA Baseline: ICAO 41st Assembly to discuss the baseline for post-pilot phases
- CORSIA Exclusivity: Required to comply under CORSIA, EU-ETS and UK-ETS which is a serious multitasking challenge that can be avoided if airlines only comply under CORSIA as the global market measure
- **EU ETS proposal:** EU ETS will apply to all the int'l flights between EU and those countries with minimal int'l traffic that would otherwise exempted under CORSIA, should those countries not volunteer to join CORSIA by 2027
