Latest developments related to ATM/SAR

➤ Bahrain FIR is fully RNAV 1 achieving maximum route efficiency and at moment applying 8 NM for traffic same level with UAE and Qatar.

- > OLDI implementation with UAE SZC and Qatar.
- > New LoAs have been signed with UAE and Qatar.
- ➤ New Voice Communication Switching System (VCS) installed 2020.



Cont. Latest developments related to ATM/SAR needs and priorities

- ➤ Bahrain's current and future ATM System is fully compliant for ADS-B, flight trajectory technologies and CPDLC operations.
- > New Air ground communication station completed in 2020.
- > New ACC with New ATM System is functional now.
- > Old ACC is refurbished as a backup facility with fully equipped and redundant systems for seamless transition during emergencies.
- > Old ACC will also be used as a fully functional operational training/simulator environment.



Identified needs and priorities

➤ World Cup 2022 preparations ongoing with Regional and Internal benchmarks / timelines.



Challenges and difficulties

➤ Ongoing proactive monitoring and assessment of post-COVID traffic volumes and complexities.

> Continuation of pandemic emergency fallback procedures.



Ongoing and Planned projects

- > Tower simulator upgrade project due for completion Q4 2022.
- > ADS- B project is ongoing. Expected delivery Q4 2022.
- ➤ Online Data Exchange Projects are on going with Kuwait and Jeddah FIRs.
- ➤ Proposed airways with KUWAIT.

The rewards of involving airspace users and neighboring ANSPs in developing and enhancing the provision of ATS.

The collaboration & cooperation with ICAO and IATA to manage current and future challenges.
