### NASAC meeting:

- The National Airspace Advisory Committee (NASAC) discussed FWC2022 operations and preparations for the event as part of its last meeting agenda.
- The Chairman of NASAC Mr. Ahmed Al Jallaf established a National ATFM Task Force to support and prepare for FWC2022 operations.
- 
- The National ATFM Task Force is chaired by Mr. Saqr Al Marashda and includes UAE ANSPs, Airlines and Airport Authorities as well as the UAE regulator.
- The Chairman of NASAC also emphasized the importance of Regional coordination and requested that UAE ATSUs are informed of any ATFM Plans that could affect their area of responsibility.

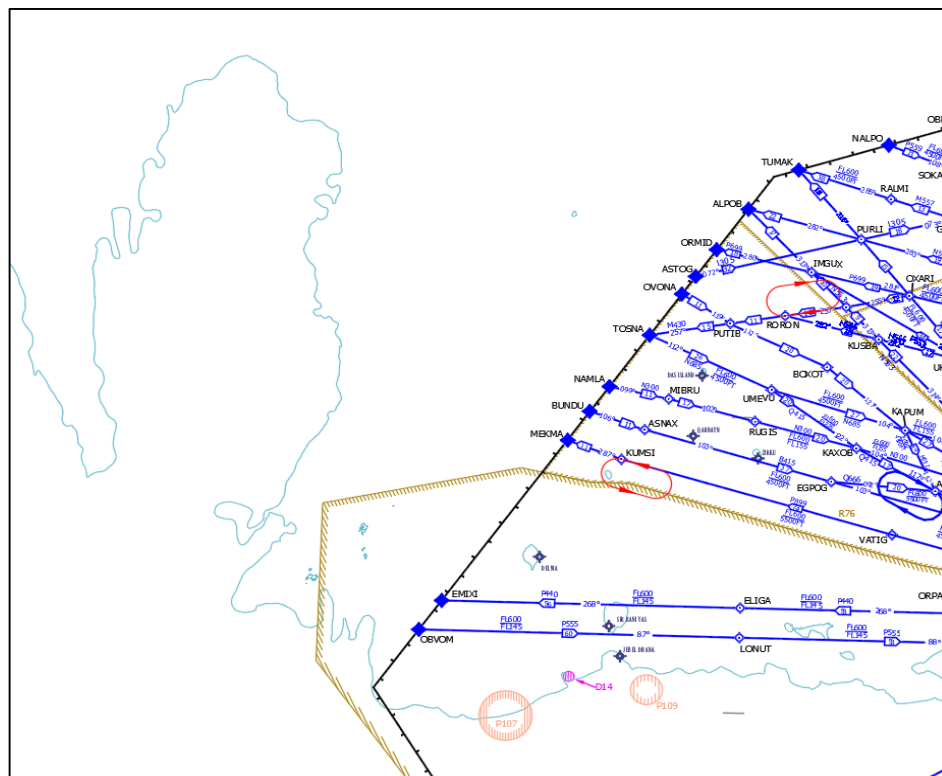

DFLOW activation:

- DFLOW activation

Emirates ACC is recalibrating its Departure Flow Management System (DFLOW) to relay the Doha ATFMU departure slots to national stakeholders.

- UAE ATFM Cell

An ATFM Cell within Emirates ACC is dedicated to the support of FWC 2022 operations and ATFM.

- ATFM Procedures

The Emirates ACC is preparing National ATFM Procedures with the National ATFM TF and will attend the daily conference calls of Doha ATFMU and relay any requirements/requests in its National daily conference call.
