

CAAF/3 follow up



Collective global aspirational Vision to reduce CO2 emissions in international aviation by 5 % by 2030, through aviation cleaner energy use



Monitoring and periodic review: Aspiring to have cleaner energy production facilities in all regions.

CAAF/4 to be convened no later than 2028, for updating the ambition on the basis of market developments.

CAAF/3 follow up

- CAAF/3 Report approved by the 231st Session of the ICAO Council, Global Framework for SAF, LCAF and other aviation cleaner energies were endorsed
- **Development of a Roadmap** for the implementation of the Global Framework for SAF
- Considerations to re-aligning ICAO Business Plan, with a view to re-prioritize, and re-allocate resources accordingly







Support towards SAF development and deployment

- **Growing participation** in ACT-SAF: more than 150 States and International Organizations with 6 States in MID
- Extensive support from several States through ACT-SAF over next three years towards
 - On-site training
 - SAF feasibility studies
 - Business implementation reports
- ICAO is in discussion with more States in the region for additional support





ICAO ACT-SAF platform of implementation support initiatives













