




Oman is Ready

Recovery


4 phases

- 3. Flood and Dam Incidents.
- 4. Tsunami
- 5. Hazardous Incidents (chemical radiological Biological).
- 6. Major Transport Incidents
- 7. Multiple Injuries and Major Fires Incidents.
- 8. Oil Spillage and Oil Pollution.
- 9. Epidemics and Outbreaks.
- 10. General Damage on Water or Food System
- 11. Effects of Wars and Armed Conflicts on Civilians.
- 12. Any other public safety hazards or incidents that require a national response




