ICAO 40th Assembly Montreal, Canada, 24 Sep-04 Oct

During the opening ceremony of its 40th Assembly in September 2019, ICAO Council President Dr. Olumuyiwa Benard Aliu presented 28 States from all ICAO regions with Council President Certificates. The Certificates were established to recognize the States' significant progress in resolving safety oversight and security deficiencies, and in improving the effective implementation of ICAO SARPs as identified through related ICAO audit programmes. Two MID States Bahrain and Qatar were presented the President award for their outstanding achievement in the areas of safety and security.

Based on their achievements in 2018, the following 16 States were recognized by the ICAO Council at this year's ceremony for their safety progress: Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Gabon, Georgia, Ghana, Guatemala, India, Mauritania, Montenegro, Mozambique, Myanmar, Papua New Guinea, Peru, Qatar, Serbia, The Congo. In the area of Aviation Security, the 17 States recognized by the Council in 2019 were: Bahrain, Croatia, Dominican Republic, Georgia, Ghana, Jamaica, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Maldives, Mauritania, Namibia, Nigeria, Qatar, Rwanda, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, Uganda

"These awards, established by the ICAO Council in support of our ongoing No Country Left Behind initiative, have been developed in order to more publicly acknowledge and encourage States' commitment and progress in making our global network even safer and more secure than it is today," commented Council President Aliu.

The effective implementation of ICAO's global Standards and Recommended Practices is considered a fundamental prerequisite today for establishing air transport's rapid global connectivity, and in turn the many socio-economic benefits it helps to realize.

ICAO 40th Assembly Montreal, Canada, 24 Sep- 04 Oct



During the 40th Session of the Assembly , a new ICAO Council was elected. The 36-member Council is the governing body of the Organization and is elected for a three-year term. The election process was divided into three parts, with the following States elected:

PART I - States of chief importance in air transport

Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Russian Federation, United Kingdom, and the United States.

PART II - States which make the largest contribution to the provision of facilities for international civil air navigation

Argentina, Colombia, Egypt, Finland, India, Mexico, Netherlands, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Africa, and Spain.

PART III - States ensuring geographic representation

Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Dominican Republic, Equatorial Guinea, Greece, Malaysia, Paraguay, Peru, Republic of Korea, Sudan, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, Zambia.

Congratulation to MID States Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Sudan and UAE for being elected in the new council.

ICAO Aviation Data and Analysis Workshop & Seminar Istanbul, Turkey, 8 - 12 July 2019



The objective of the ICAO Aviation Data and Analysis Workshop & Seminar was to bring together all stakeholders (Regulators, Air Navigation Service Providers - ANSPs, Aerodrome Operators, Aircraft Operators, International Organizations and Industry) to review the current situation and trends of aviation in the EUR/NAT and MID Regions. The workshop/ Seminar focused on the synergies between aviation, tourism and trade in order to provide an understanding of the challenges and needs of the different stakeholders, considering cost effectiveness. The use of civil aviation data analysis for planning and decision making in ICAO, national administrations, airlines, airports and ANSPs were also addressed.

The Special Coordination Meeting on the Implementation of ATM Contingency Arrangements was successfully conducted in Muscat, Oman from 16 to 18 July 2019. FAL Panel PNR TF meeting Cairo, Egypt, 18 – 20 August 2019



ICAO's Air Transport Committee (ATC) agreed to a proposal made by the Secretariat that a FALP Working Group be established to consider proposals for Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) on the collection, use, processing and protection of passenger name records (PNR) data in line with United Nations Security Council resolution 2396 (2017).The FAL Panel: Passenger Name Record Task Force (PNR-TF) Meeting was held at the ICAO MID Regional Office, Cairo, Egypt. The meeting was attended by a total of thirty nine (39) participants from fourteen (14) States (Botswana, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, Ghana, Kenya, Portugal, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, UAE, United Kingdom, and United States of America) and four (4) Organizations (EU, IATA, UNODC and WCO) in addition to ICAO.
