After working in the private sector in engineering and consultancy for railway and road infrastructure projects, she joined Adif in 2007. From that time until 2015, she held successive positions as Works Manager, Head of Infrastructures and Area Manager in the construction of the Madrid-Galicia High Speed Line. At the end of that year, she requested a leave of absence from Adif and was appointed Director of Mobility and Infrastructures of the Provincial Council of Pontevedra.
