### 1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 In accordance with the provisions of Article 50 a) of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, African States have set up a mechanism based on principles of cooperation and/or rotation at the regional level and in each of the five African Regions of the African Union.
- 1.2 In this connexion, African States have the honour to inform the  $36^{th}$  Session of ICAO Assembly that they hereby unanimously nominate the following countries for election to the Council of the Organization for the period 2008 2010:
