

Objectives of RASFALG-AFI

Establishment

- ► The First Steering Committee (SC) meeting of the AFI SECFAL Plan endorsed the establishment of RASFALG-AFI under the umbrella of AFCAC with the objective to:
 - support the AFI SECFAL SC to identify challenges facing aviation security and facilitation in the region and to increase awareness among stakeholders
 - support the SC in monitoring progress and implementing the AFI SECFAL Plan in order to improve aviation security and facilitation in the region



Objectives of RASFALG-AFI

Establishment (cont'd)

- make technical recommendations to the SC on the means to facilitate the implementation of the AFI SECFAL Plan
- provide SC with technical input with regard to the resolution of States' security and facilitation deficiencies with emphasis and priority to States with SSeC and those referred to the MARB
- provide assistance to States for resolving security oversight deficiencies and increasing effective implementation of the 8 Critical Elements (CE) of an effective State aviation security oversight system



Objectives of RASFALG-AFI

- ► Submit an annual Work Programme to the AFI SECFAL Plan SC for approval
- Participate in any activities relating to and aimed at implementing the Work Programme
- Report on the progress made on the Work Programme and make recommendations for consideration by the SC



Composition of the RASFALG-AFI

Membership

- Members of RASFG-AFI are designated by States in accordance with the set criteria
- > AFI Experts participating in ICAO AVSEC Panel and Facilitation Panel
- > One Expert from each Aviation Security Training Centre (ASTC)
- One Expert from Regional Economic Communities having Aviation Security and Facilitation background



Composition of the RASFALG-AFI

- ► Secretariat
- > AFCAC provides secretariat services
- Support from ICAO Regional Offices, in particular AFI SECFAL Plan Secretariat



Team of Experts of RASFALG-AFI

► Terms of Reference:

The RASFG-AFI may establish Task Force, Working Group or TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TEAM with the objective to:

- provide support in the identification of security & facilitation issues
- > deliver technical inputs and recommendations for the resolution of deficiencies
- provide Assistance to States for resolving security oversight deficiencies and increase El of the 8 CEs



SIX Focus Areas for the Intervention of the Expert Teams

- Establishment of Oversight Systems
- Security Oversight Implementation
- Significant Security Concerns
- Risk Assessment New and Emerging Threats
- > Facilitation: Cargo, AVSEC and Infrastructure
- Training

➤ Training on Crisis Management and other workshops underway




CONCLUSION
