Goals

Improvement of synergy between Postal, Border and Aviation security

- Timely and seamless access for free flowing communications and commerce to all inhabitants of the world
- Improved efficiencies in operations for post and other entities of the global supply chain

>Improved security, based on better risk assessments



Results

- In 2014 UPU Postal Security Standards became mandatory (Developed in cooperation with ICAO)
- UPU governing bodies adopted a convention change to comply with address the requirements of electronic advance data
- >Updated EDI messages to enable preadvice messaging
- Development of Customs Declaration System (CDS), which is available to posts and customs administrations



Currently working with ICAO to finalize a Global Awareness Campaign for postal customers

- ➢Working with IATA on a solution to address postal items that are delayed in transit locations
- Developed a dangerous goods training course of postal operators (ICAO, IATA, and members contributed to this effort)



- Mutual acceptance and agreement of data requirements between all entities of the supply chain
- A Reasonable risk based approach to safety and security by all parties
- Continue to educate global supply chain partners of the rules and requirements of the postal business model
- Clearer understanding of the evolving postal model and its capabilities as it relates to advance cargo information
