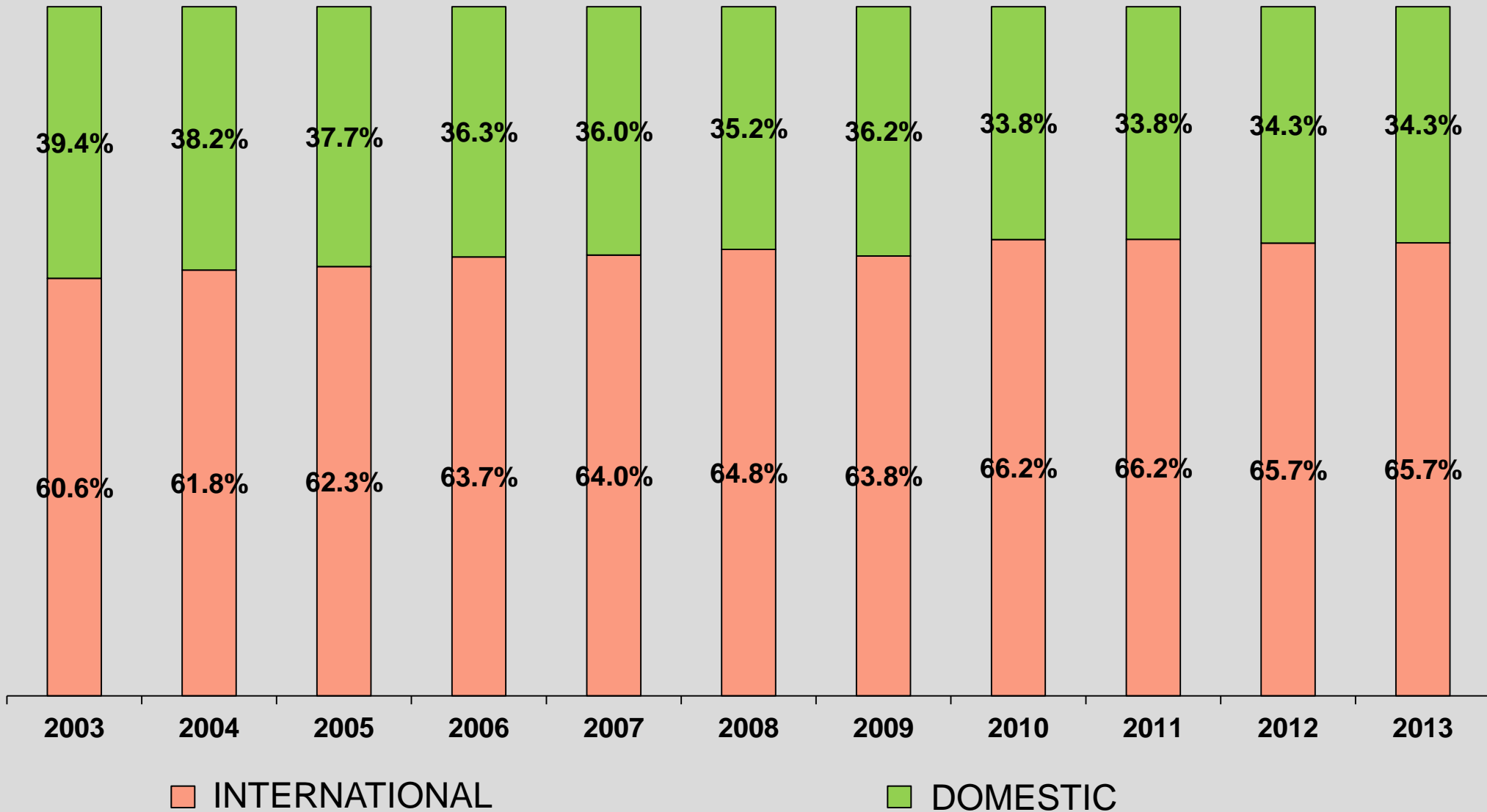

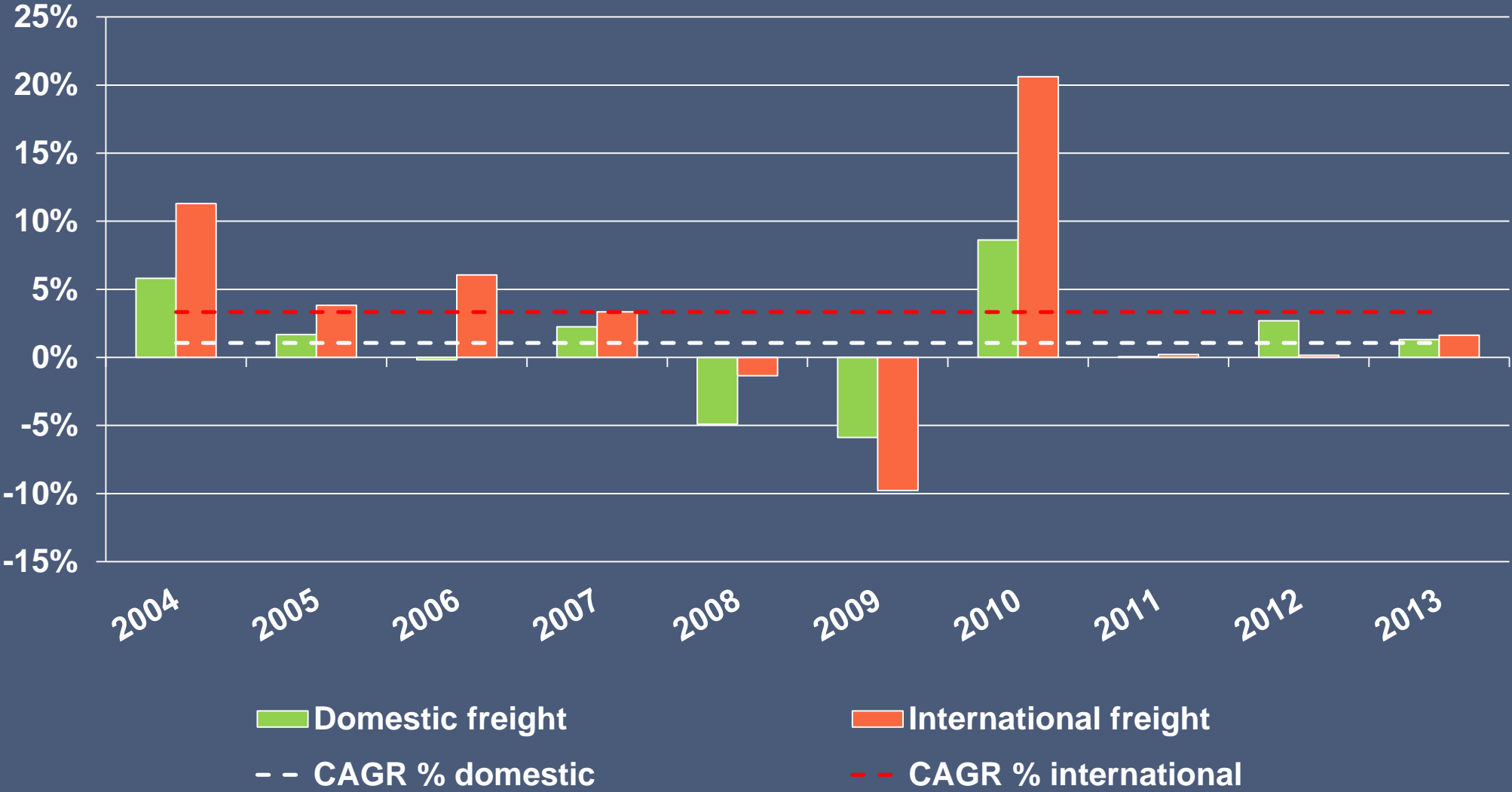

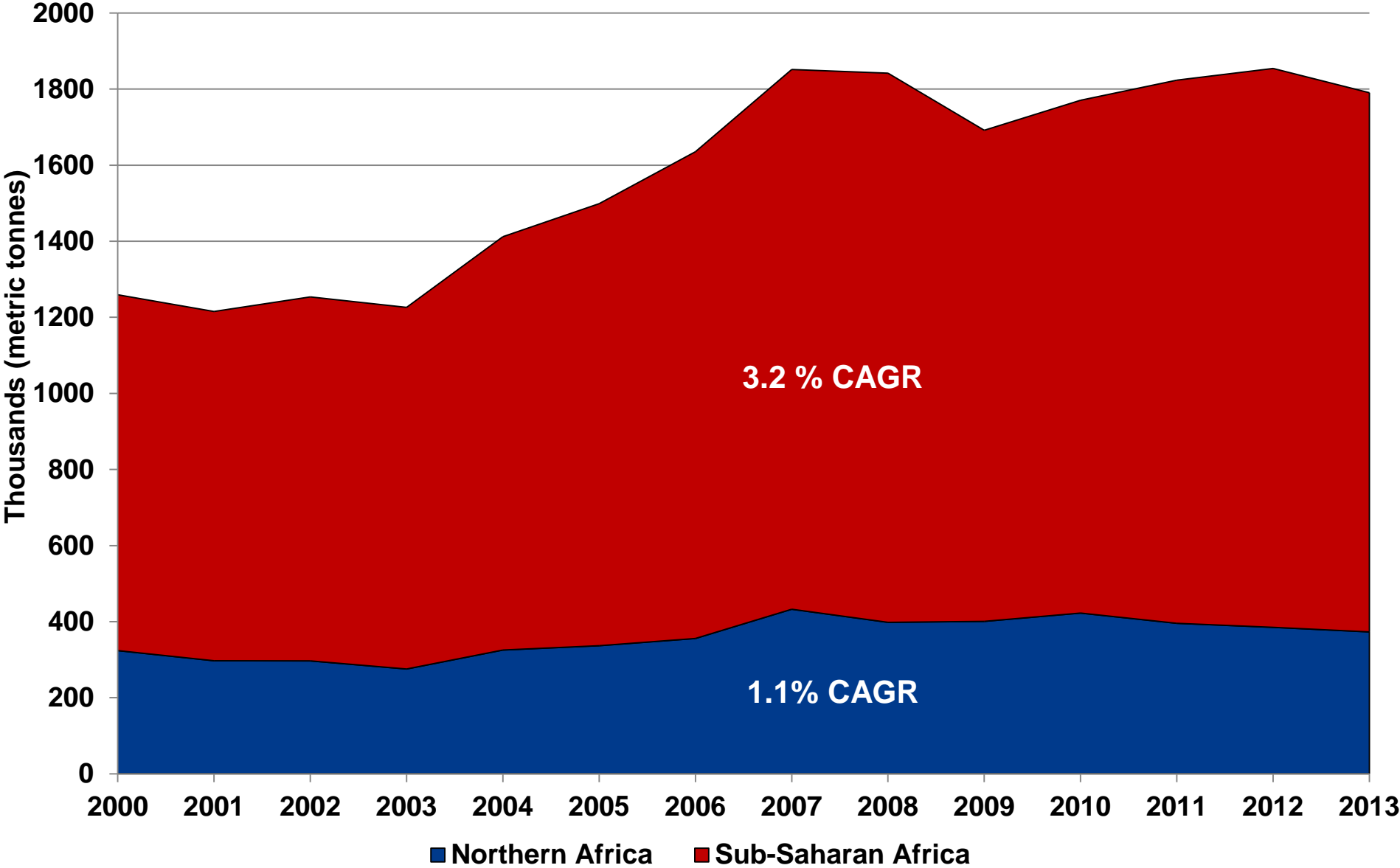
# EVOLUTION OF INTERNATIONAL TO DOMESTIC FREIGHT TRAFFIC (2003-2013)



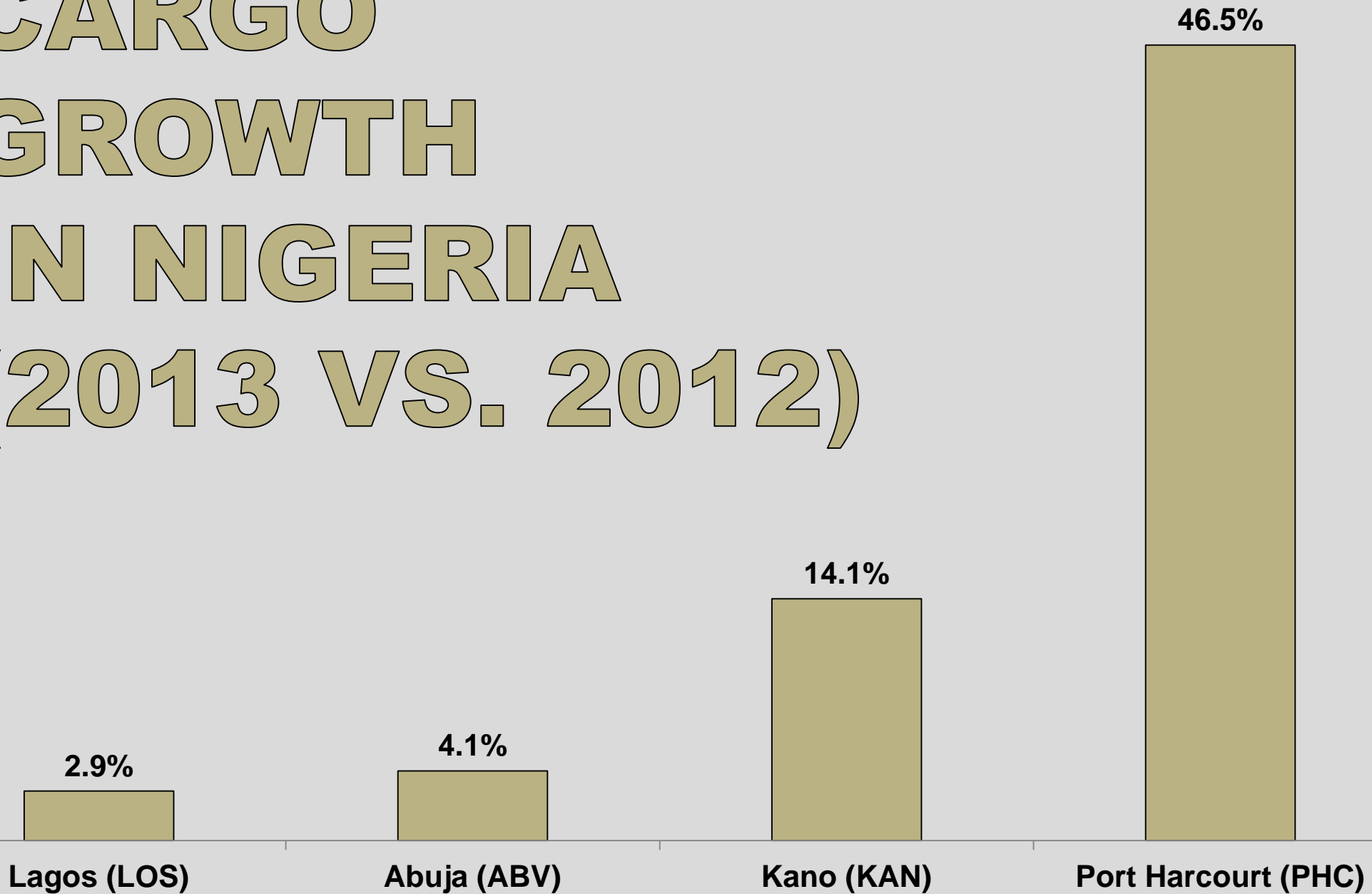
# EVOLUTION OF WORLDWIDE FREIGHT TRAFFIC GROWTH (2003-2013)



# EVOLUTION OF CARGO TRAFFIC IN AFRICA



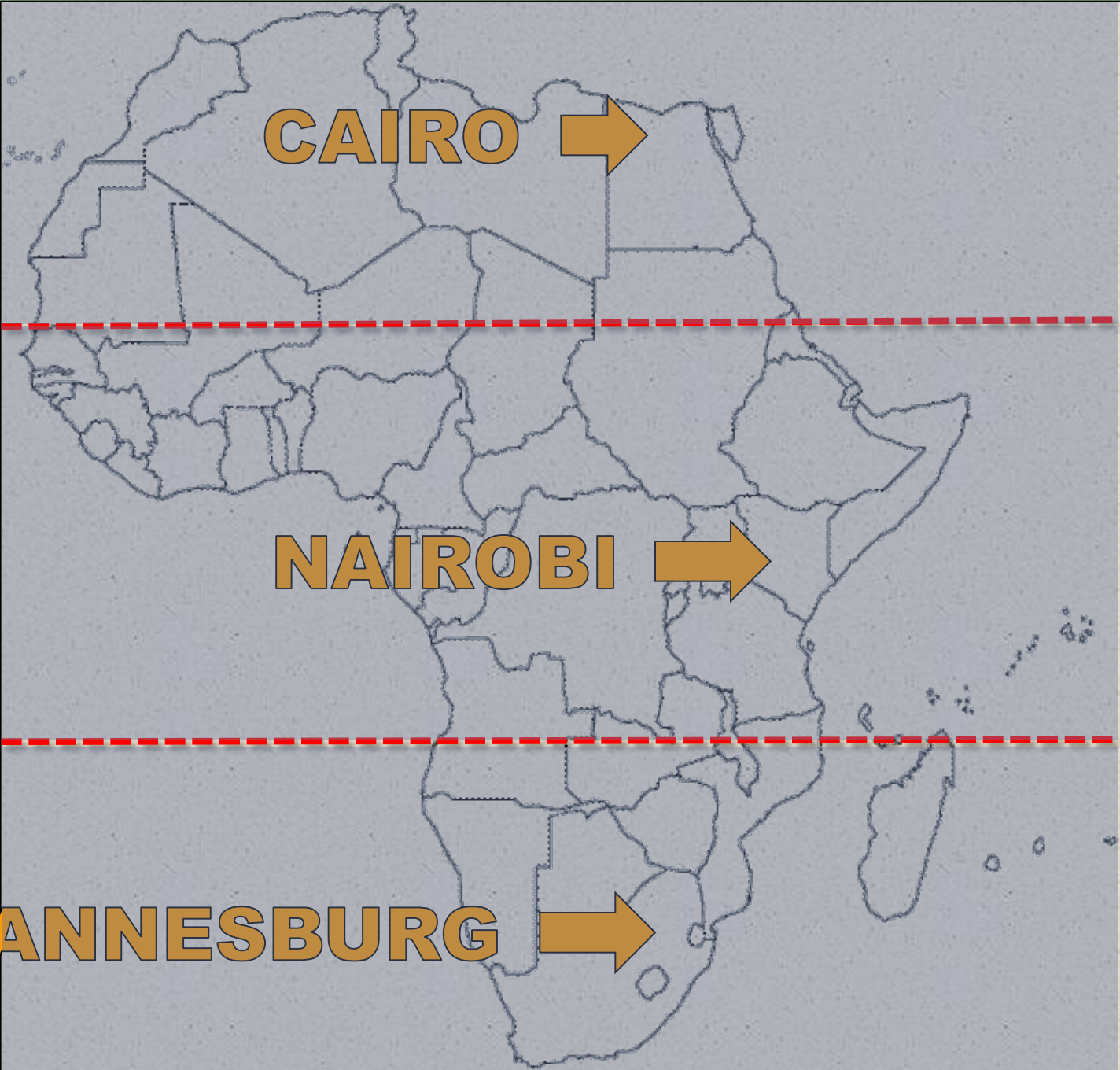
# CARGO GROWTH IN NIGERIA (2013 VS. 2012)
