ICAO TAXATION POLICY

- International Civil Aviation- taxation a sensitive and vexed subject
- ICAO Policy on taxation
 - Document 9082
 - Document 8632
- Tax: A levy that is designed to raise national or local government revenues which are generally not applied to civil aviation in their entirety or on a cost specific basis.
- Charge: A levy that is designed and applied specifically to recover the costs of providing facilities and services for civil aviation.

INDUSTRY REACTION & IMPACT

- IATA actively campaigns against revenue authorities worldwide that fail to honour ICAO taxation principles
- ACI's policy is to oppose the proliferation of taxes imposed solely on air transport and used for non-aviation purposes
- Increasing concern with the types and levels of taxes beyond scope of ICAO policy
- Tourism Tax, Air Passenger Duty, Solidarity Tax, Air Travel Tax, Tourism Enhancement Fee, VAT
- Negative Impact on global economy, economic recovery and economic welfare
- Imposition and withdrawal of taxes over the years
 - Europe
 - Latin America
 - Caribbean



 - -Technological resources
 - Physical facilities
 - Training and development
 - -Administrative support
