Coaching and Mentoring


- Complementary of tools
- Coaching
 - ➤ Need to have skilled/trained individuals with a mandate for developing people
 - ➤ Tailored to organisational context
- Mentoring
 - ➤ Need to have a one-to-one, trusted relation
 - ➤ External to organisation no authority/hierarchy link



The way forward
