### FIRST STEPS ON CO2 REDUCTION

- ❖ Caribbean Airlines acquired fifteen (15) **B737-800** in 2011 which includes wing tips
- Caribbean Airlines upgraded its fleet from Dash 8s to ATRs in 2012
- Caribbean Airlines got their two B767 certified with ETOPs 180
- Several airline operational improvements were implemented
- ❖ There are electrical GPU and PCA installed in fourteen (14) Jetbriges within the PIARCO International Airport to reduce the APU usage
- Energy-efficiency programs are being implemented at the **Airports**
- Several PBN initiatives have been implemented



# **EXPECTED RESULTS**



#### **DIRECT BENEFITS**

An average reduction of 20,000 CO<sub>2</sub> tonnes per year from 2017 on international flights (ICAO Definition) performed by Caribbean Airlines Limited (CAL).




- 5,027 CO<sub>2</sub> tonnes per year from the domestic flights performed by CAL
- 275 CO<sub>2</sub> tonnes per year from airports activities
- At least 6,480 CO<sub>2</sub> tonnes per year from international operations performed by other international airlines in the country.
