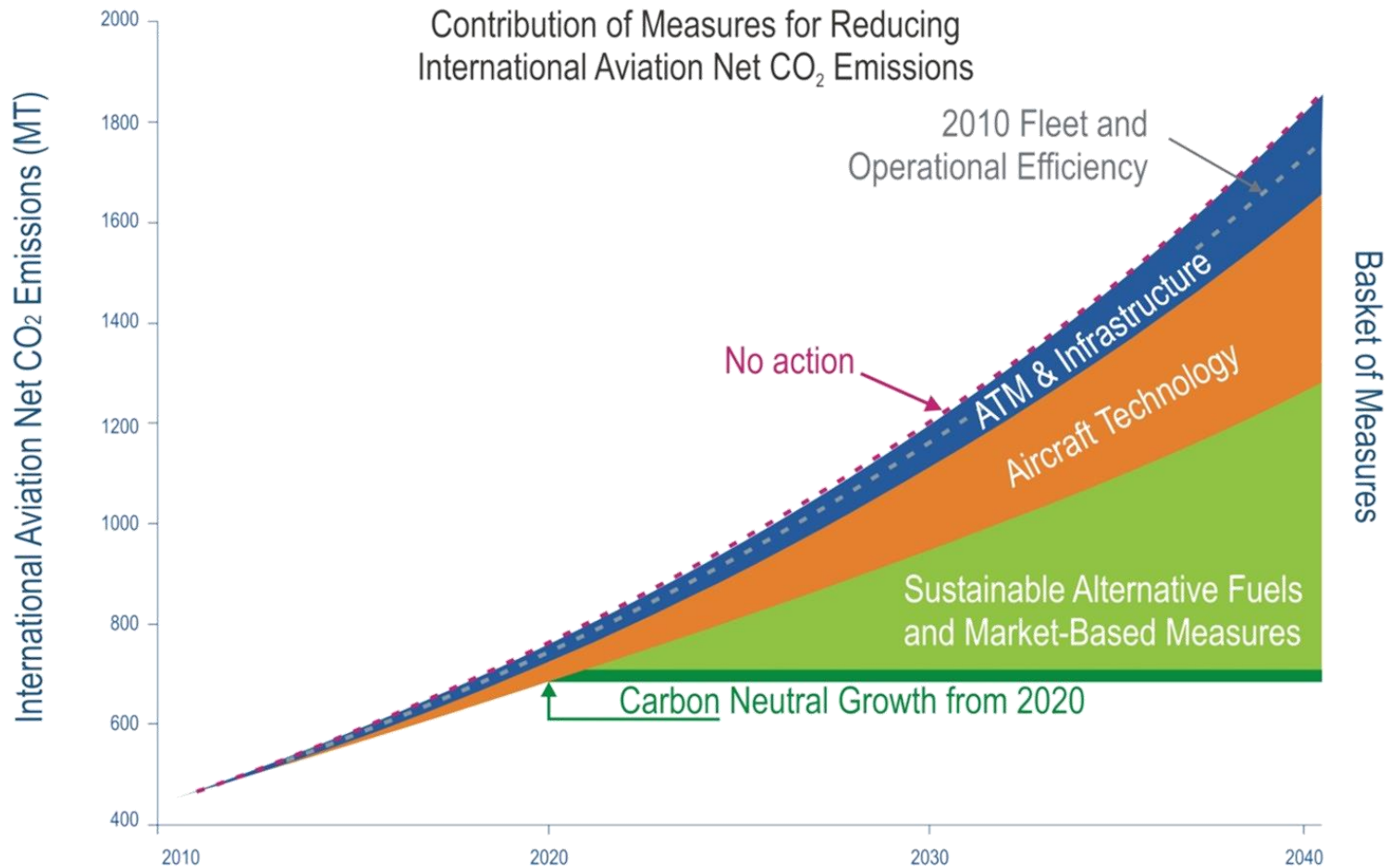

State's Action Plans and Assistance

- *ICAO and its Member States to take collective efforts to address climate change and to identify a global solution*
- *A basket of measures identified at ICAO*
- States' Action Plans - practical means for States to communicate their activities to address CO₂ emissions from international civil aviation.

EU and ICAO to cooperate on assistance to States

Project: "Capacity building for CO₂ mitigation from international aviation"

- Overall objective: *To assist States in addressing aviation emissions by implementing capacity building activities that will support the development of low carbon air transport:*
- Specific objectives: *to support the ability to track, manage and reduce their aviation emissions*
- EU funding: *EUR 6.5 million*

Scope of the project:

- 42 month, starting January 2014

How the States were selected to participate in the project?

- *States that have indicated the political willingness to develop a State action plan*
- *States that have officially requested assistance from ICAO*
- *States that have met the Country Selection Criteria*

Project activities:

- *Capacity building for the development of States' action and their inclusion into ICAO State Action Plans*
- *Establishment of aviation environmental information systems and creating national emissions inventories for aviation*
- *Piloting the implementation of environmental and operational measures to reduce fuel consumption*

- *Close cooperation of EU, ICAO experts and participating States*
- *Extensive experience on regional capacity building from ICAO*
- *Willingness of States to actively engage and take mitigation action in aviation sector*
