



ICAO – EC Objective

To contribute to the mitigation of CO₂ emissions from international aviation in the selected States, by implementing capacity building activities that will support the development of low carbon air transport and environmental sustainability





ICAO-EC Project objectives

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE 1:

ACTION PLANS DEVELOPMENT

Improved capacity of the National Civil Aviation authorities to develop their Action Plan on CO2 emissions reduction from international aviation.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE 3:

IMPLEMENTATION OF MITIGATION MEASURES

Priority mitigation measures identified, evaluated and partly implemented.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE 2: AVIATION ENVIRONMENTAL

SYSTEMS (AES)

Efficient CO2 emission monitoring system for international aviation developed in each selected Member State.





ICAO-EC Project results

AREA OF ACTIVITY 1

Capacity building for the development of State Action Plans

National Action Plan teams built in selected Member States. members of staff in each national aviation authority/relevant stakeholder organizations trained to develop Action Plans.

Country specific ICAO Action Plans developed in selected Member States or Group of States and submitted to ICAO.

AREA OF ACTIVITY 2

Setting up aviation environmental systems and creating national emissions inventories for aviation

Aviation environmental system (AES) developed in the selected Member States.

members from national authorities/relevant stakeholder organizations in selected Member State trained to work with the AES and to have the capacity to report on aviation emissions for States inventories.





ICAO-EC: Results

AREA OF ACTIVITY 3

Piloting the implementation of measures to reduce fuel consumption through environmental measures including operational measures

feasibility studies on proposed pilot measures contained in the action plans are developed Measures to improve environmental benefits and reduce aviation fuel consumption including operational measures, such as Air Traffic Management, have been selected and implemented



ICAO ENVIRONMENT ICAO – EC current Status

- States selected and committed to participate
- State Focal Points for the project already nominated
- ICAO Project consultants and local consultants for Africa and the Caribbean recruited
- Inception report, new budget, new timeline/ work plan developed and approved
- National Action Plan Teams officially established in 11 States
- 1rst Steering Committee in January 2015: Positive feedback received on the project progress
- Purchase/Installation of equipment for the State Focal Points
- Projects 'Kick-off seminars' in the Caribbean and in Africa

Next steps:

- AES to be finalized and implemented in selected States
- Action Plans submitted by September 2015





Global Assistance: ICAO-UNDP-GEF





• Objective:

To provide assistance to Developing Countries and Small Islands States resulting in the reduction of CO2 emissions



Project components:

1-Identification of low emissions aviation measures in developing States and SIDS;

2-Support developing States and SIDS to strengthen their national capacities and to improve their national processes and mechanisms for the reduction of aviation emissions;

3-Establishment of a technical support platform for the implementation of low emissions measures;


4-Demonstration of low emissions aviation measures in developing States and SIDS – Pilot Project in Jamaica

ICAO – UNDP with GEF financing Project components





- ICAO developed a Project Identification Form (PIF)
- PIF approved by GEF in 2013
- 50.000 USD allocated to develop Project
 Description Document
- Project Description Document submitted to UNDP in July 2014
- Approved by UNDP in August 2014
- Project Description Document approved by GEF in November 2014

Project expected to start Spring 2015



- Have a mitigation Project
- Use the Action Plan Platform and guidance to Request for Assistance
- Coordinate with ICAO for assistance and facilitation
- Independently or using ICAO assistance tap Sources of Mitigation Finance to secure financing.
