### 6. **Social functions**

6.1 **Sound and Light Show, Giza Pyramids.** The Egyptian Civil Aviation Authority is pleased to invite all participants to attend a Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids on Tuesday, 30 March 2004, at 6:30 PM (show in English language). Transportation will be made available **ONLY** from the CICC and buses will depart immediately at the end of the afternoon sessions, i.e. on Tuesday, 30 March at 1715 hours.

### 7. **Miscellaneous**

7.1 **Egyptair counters.** Egyptair has two counters at the main entrance and in the vicinity of the Email centre. These counters provide the delegates with services for making travel arrangements, including confirmation of return tickets, as well as post office and banking facilities.

7.2 **New daily shuttle service.** The Karnak Travel Agency is making available additional daily bus services from the CICC to the Sonesta, Baron, Meridien, Sheraton, Mövenpick and Novotel hotels. Buses will leave the CICC at 1100, 1400 and 1500 hours.

7.3 **Access to Secretariat area.** Security have instructions to permit only members of the CICC staff, Egyptian CAA and ICAO Secretariat into the general Secretariat area. As this is a shared secretariat area and in the interest of ensuring the proper level of security, only those members of the Secretariat are permitted in this area.
