# SLTD Database

## *Stolen and Lost Travel Documents*



**INTERPOL General Secretariat developed the ASF-SLTD database, which has been operational since June 2002**

### Purpose

**To enable law enforcement entities to prevent lost/stolen documents from being used in an illegal manner**

### Function

**The exchange of accurate, reliable information on lost/stolen travel documents, available on a real-time basis, and accessible from the collection created at the general Secretariat and/or from national databases.**

# SLTD Data Field

## Mandatory Field

- DIN (Document Identification Number)\*
- Issuing Country (ICAO three-letter code)
- Type of document
- Type of fraud (Stolen blank or lost by bearer/stolen from bearer or revoked)

## Desirable field

- Theft reporting country
- Date of Issue (if not a blank document)
- Date of expiry of document (if not a blank document)
- Review date (Date when the record will automatically be deleted - 10 years by default)
- National reference number (Reporting NCB's own reference for the theft)
- Stolen on (Date of theft)
- Add Info (no-nominal)

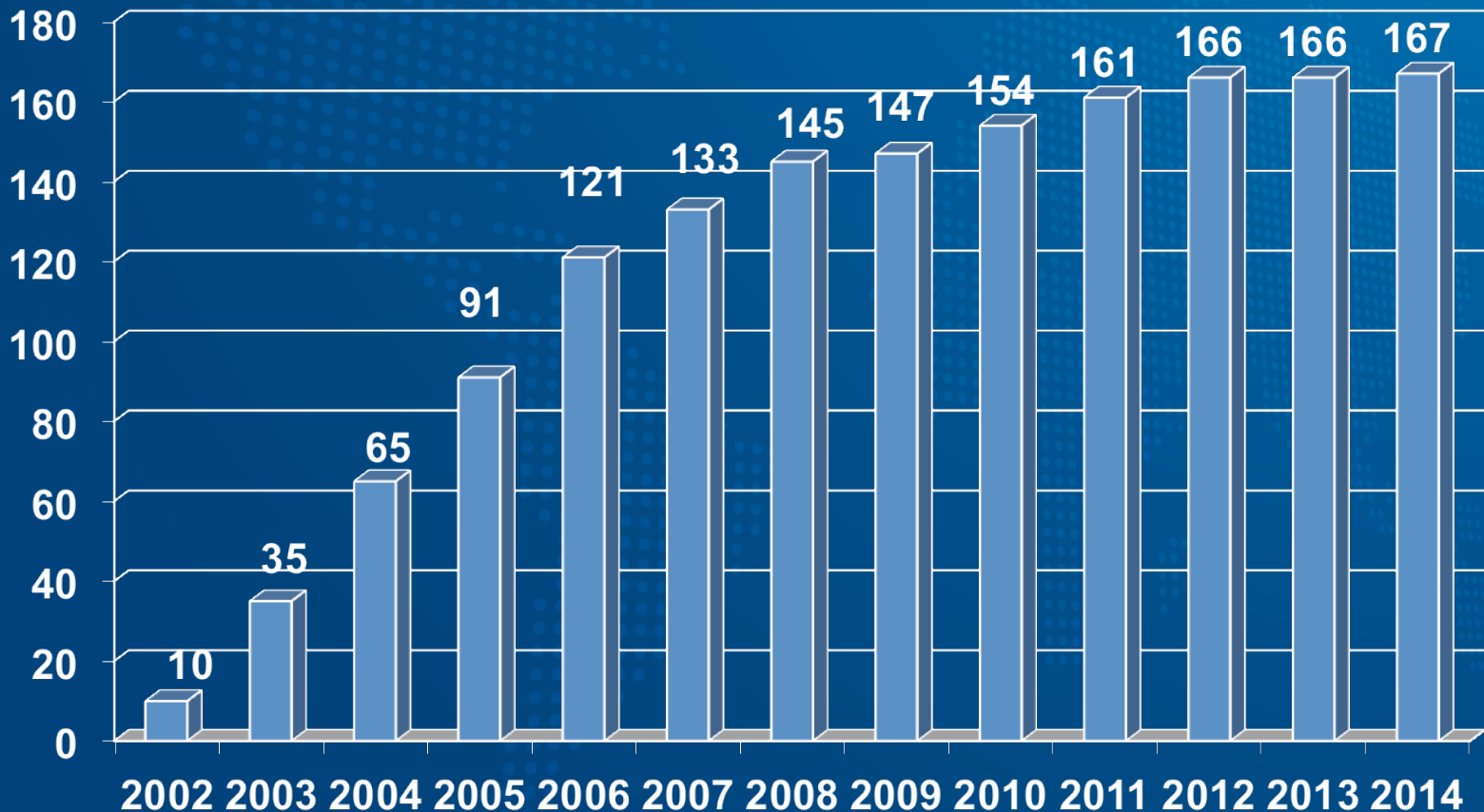

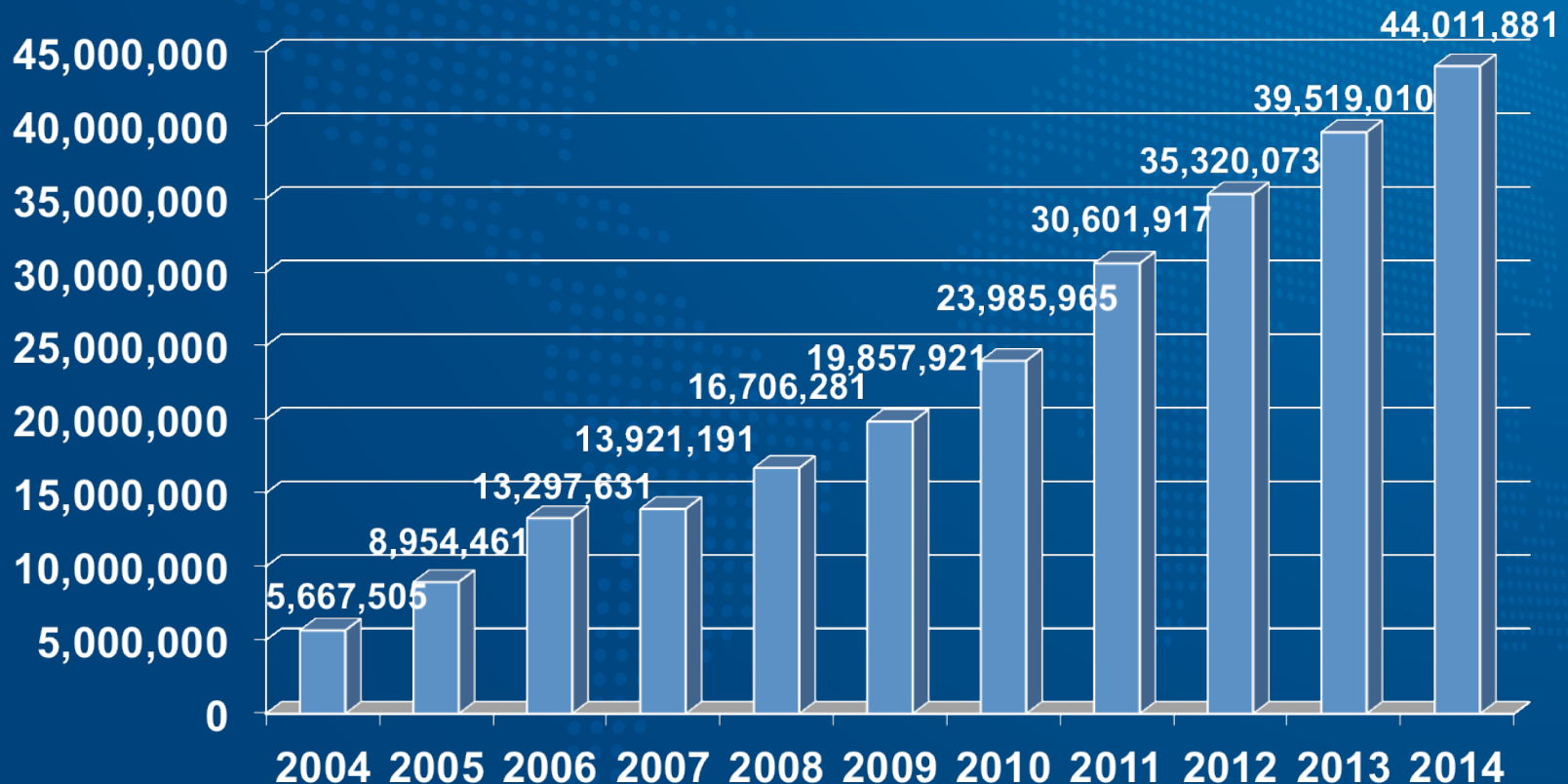
- 167 countries contributing to SLTD

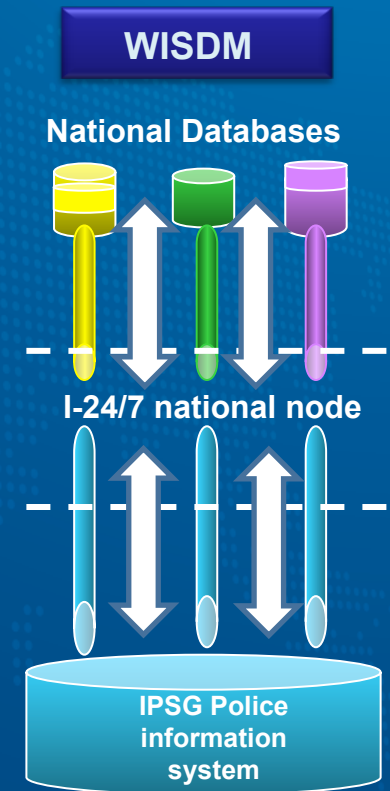

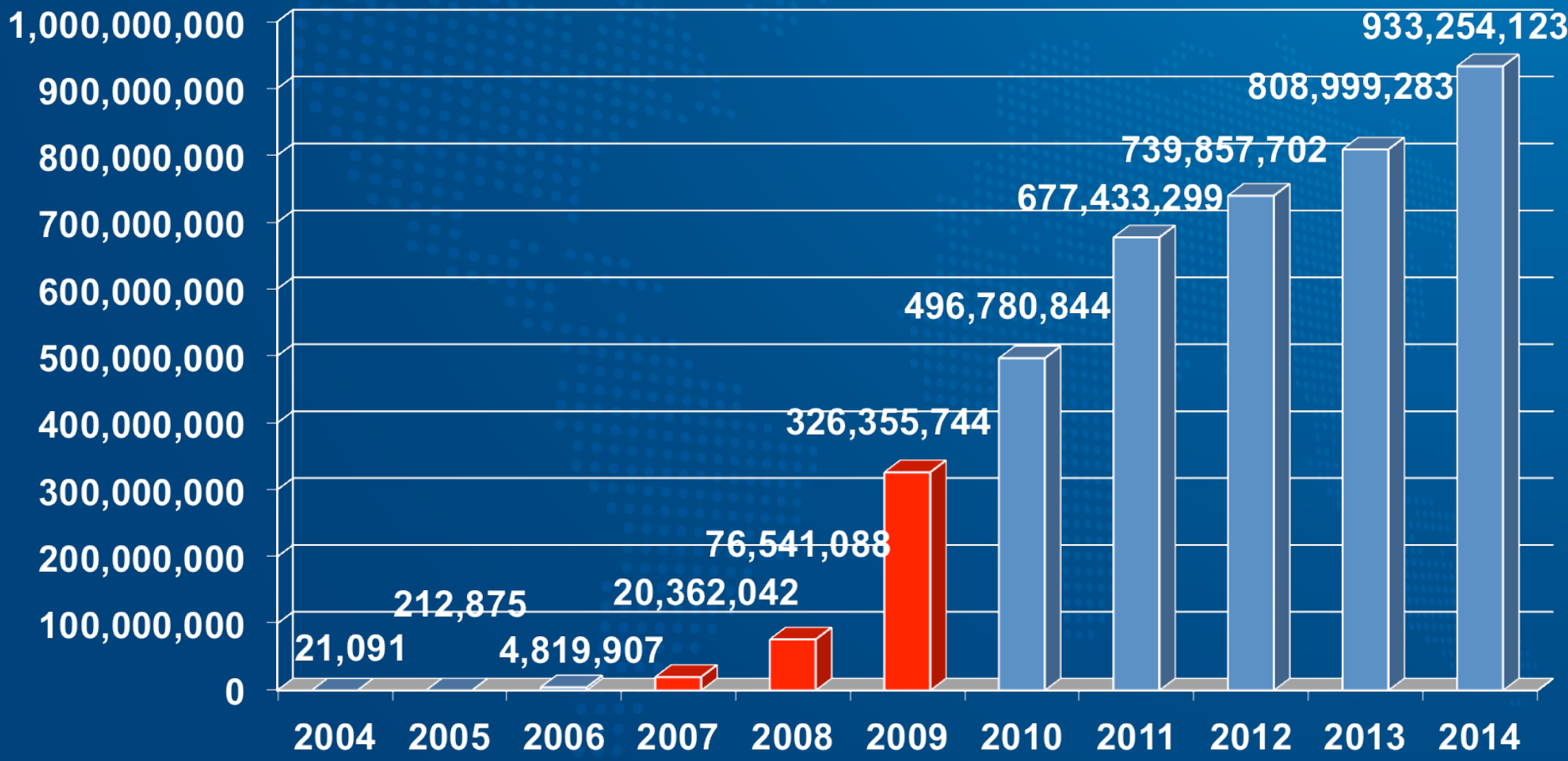
