Brief Biography of Speaker:

Joël Morin is the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Assistant Director for Global ATM Harmonization & Policy, headquartered in Montreal. He is coordinating IATA's efforts to ensure the harmonized and cost effective evolution of ATM across the globe. In this role he works very closely with other International organizations such as the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and Civil Air Navigation Services Organization (CANSO) to develop global policy for Air Traffic Management.

Prior to joining IATA in 2011, Mr. Morin enjoyed a diverse 35 year operational and management career in Canadian air traffic control that saw the introduction of the first automated ATM systems through to the operational use of state-of-the-art systems such as ADS-B and CPDLC. Mr. Morin has been involved in ATM R&D collaboration with the FAA and EUROCONTROL; the implementation of coordinated ATFM and the migration from a State-operated to a fully privatized ANSP in Canada. He is the recipient of a Deputy Minister's Commendation and a Chairman's Award of Excellence for his leadership role in implementing ATM service charges.

Mr. Morin is a member of a number of ICAO panels and participated in the drafting of the Collaborative ATFM Manual.
