



## **Nikolaos IOSIF**

### **Manager, Airfield Services - Athens International Airport**

Mr. Iosif is Manager of Airfield Services at Athens International Airport. Born in Athens (Greece) in 1971, he obtained a Master's Degree in Engineering Manufacture & Management at UMIST in Manchester in 1998 and his MBA with specialization in Transport & Logistics at the Athens University of Economics & Business (AUEB) in 2003.

He joined AIA in 1999 during airport construction, as a Project Engineer in the Technical Team in charge of the Airport Air Navigation Equipment and ATC related systems. Following airport opening in 2001, he held several positions, including Senior Supervisor of the Airport Services Operations Center (ASOC) and Head Ground Handling Services & Concessions in 2003. In that capacity, he was responsible for the efficient planning of the airport's ground handling resources for the 2004 Olympic Games, and the development of the operational processes of the new General Aviation Facility.

In 2005, he was appointed Airport Duty Officer, being the senior airport management official on duty, with overall responsibility for the safe, smooth and efficient operation of the airport. Since 2014, he has assumed the duties of Manager, Airfield Services, being responsible for the airport's safe airside processes and smooth operation of ASOC on a 24-hour basis.

Before joining Athens International Airport (AIA), he has worked as Assistant Air Traffic Controller in the Hellenic Air Force (HAF) during his military service from 1990 to 1992. In the summer of 1993, he worked as a Radio Navigator & Flight Liaison Officer in the fire-fighting helicopters, while during his studies, he held other fixed-term positions in the aviation and engineering sector.

Since 2014, he holds an EASA CPL(A) licence with ATPL frozen, having obtained his first Commercial Pilot License at FlightSafety USA back in 1990. In 2014, he also graduated from the ACI-ICAO Airport Management Professional Accreditation Programme (AMPAP). Since 2016, he has been appointed as Athens A-CDM Project Manager. Recently, he was nominated as one of the 3 representatives of ACI Europe in the Eurocontrol NDOP Airport Integration Taskforce. He is married with one daughter and one son.
