Mr. van Blijenburgh has been involved with remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS) since 1987.

As the founder of Euro UVS (1997), which changed its name to UVS International (2000), he has been the President of this internationally operating non-profit association dedicated to unmanned systems and representing over 5000 companies.

He is the creator of the International RPAS Coordination Council, which federates the 24 national RPAS association, and has participated in all UAS/RPAS/drone-related regulatory activities deployed by ICAO, European Commission, EASA, and Joint Aviation Authorities (JAA).

He is the initiator of the RPAS-related standards activities at EUROCAE (WG73 & WG93) and the special advisor to the management team of both working groups.

He is the editor and publisher of the "RPAS: The Global Perspective"- an annual RPAS reference publication currently in its 15th year.

He has been the organizer & conference chair of the annual RPAS Regulatory, Policy & Innovation Forum for 18 years and of the annual Civil RPAS Operators & Operations Forum for 6 years.
