John Binder serves as the Executive Director of the Alaska International Airport System (AIAS) and Deputy Commissioner of Aviation for the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF).

Mr. Binder oversees the management of the state's 239 airports including the Anchorage and Fairbanks International Airports. The Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport is North America's 2nd busiest cargo airport and currently ranked 5th in the world for landed cargo weight. John also serves on the executive board of the National Association of State Aviation Officials, is a Trustee for The International Air Cargo Association, and is an Accredited Airport Executive of the American Association of Airport Executives.

Mr. Binder is a former U.S. Air Force pilot and combat veteran with over 21 years of service, having retired as a commander and a command pilot with both fighter and trainer aircraft experience in the F-15C Eagle, T-38 Talon, and the T-6 Texan II.
