


## Defining a Slot

Slot: a permission given by a coordinator for a planned operation to use the full range of airport infrastructure necessary to arrive or depart at a Level 3 airport on a specific date and time.



## State of the Industry



Airport infrastructure is not sufficient to meet current and forecast demand.



## Consistent Global Standards One Flight, two airports, one rule




Single, global, consistent standard

## Independent, Transparent Coordination: Ensuring Fair and Neutral decisions

Numbers of Coordinated Airports by Region




➤ The greater the unsatisfied demand for slots, the greater the need for an independent, transparent and non-discriminatory approach to

promoting fair and neutral airport

access and competition.

Demand for airport slot coordination is proportional to unsatisfied airline demand for constrained airport facilities.

## WSG Strategic Review

- ✓ Joint initiative of IATA, Airports Council International (ACI) and the Worldwide Airport Coordinators Group (WWACG) to:
  - Improve and optimize the WSG
  - Ensure the policies and procedures remain relevant
  - Reinforce the benefits of the single global process for slot allocation
- Four priority areas:
  - Looking at the rules for access to congested airports whilst maintaining fair, transparent and equal access to all
  - Enhancing the application of slot performance monitoring
  - Looking at the processes involved in retaining historic slots
  - Enhancing the current airport level principles
