Nancy Young is the Vice President of Environmental Affairs at Airlines for America® (A4A). An environmental attorney with over twenty-five years of experience, Ms. Young directs the A4A environmental sustainability programs, represents the A4A airlines in international negotiations regarding aircraft noise and emissions standards, and provides counsel on other environmental issues of significance. She serves on the Steering Group and as environmental co-lead of the Commercial Aviation Alternative Fuels Initiative® (CAAFI), which is working to hasten the deployment of commercially viable, environmentally preferred alternative jet fuels, and participates in the working groups under the International Civil Aviation Organization's Committee on Aviation Environmental Protection.
