
Implementing a Green Revolving Fund at Montreal-Trudeau

- GRF is a revolving fund that invests money into infrastructure renovations projects to lower utility and operating costs
- Savings from those improvements go back to the fund to finance future projects
- Turns COST INTO INVESTMENTS
- YUL already spends \$3 million a year on terminal building maintenance, so why not use that money for GRF projects instead?
