Valujet Flight 592

- 11 May 1996
- Florida Everglades
- 110 fatalities
- Fire, loss of control
- Chemical oxygen generators improperly prepared, packaged and identified






Need for International Standards

- Pan American Flight 160
- All crew members killed
- Fire caused by reaction between nitric acid and sawdust
- Improperly packed, no notification to crew, no training
- Lack of direct government control over the transport of dangerous goods by air




ICAO — Genesis

- International Civil Aviation Organization
- Specialized agency of the United Nations
- 1944 the Chicago Convention
 - 11 September, President Roosevelt invited the world to work on a new convention for international aviation
 - 7 December 1944 Convention on International Civil Aviation signed by 52 States
 - Currently 191 Contracting States
 - ICAO preceded the United Nations


ICAO — Raison D'être

- The safe and orderly development of international civil aviation
- States work through ICAO to form agreements on the minimum Standards that must be met for safe, secure, efficient and green international aviation
- Nineteen Annexes to Chicago Convention
- Annex 18 The Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air


- The Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air
 - "The Standards and Recommended Practices of this Annex shall be applicable to all international operations of civil aircraft."
 - "Each Contracting State shall take the necessary measures to achieve compliance with the detailed provisions contained in the Technical Instructions."
