Mr. Devan Ramasamy is a Senior Technical Advisor with the UK Civil Aviation Authority International which is a wholly owned subsidiary of the United Kingdom CAA. He is currently based at the South East Asia Office in Kuala Lumpur.

Mr. Ramasamy has also worked with the General Civil Aviation Authority of the United Arab Emirates from November 2009 to March 2012 where he was involved in the introduction of CAR M (similar to EASA Part M) and the training of GCAA Inspectors in CAR 145/CAR M and other ICAO regulatory functions including Safety Management System training. As result of his experience, he was tasked with the oversight of a major airline and a highly prestigious air operator within the region.

Before joining the UK CAA in 1998, Mr. Ramasamy was a Licensed Engineer (Avionics) with airlines/MROs based in the UK and overseas before becoming a Quality Engineer in 1989. His last position before joining the CAA was as a Quality Manager for a major airline. He currently holds an EASA Part 66 Licence (categories B1/B2/C) and a Diploma in Aero-Mechanical Engineering and Supervisory Management.
