With over 31 years of experience in aviation, Mr. Zoa Etundi has been Representative of Cameroon to ICAO since 2008. He was a member of the ICAO Council from 2008 to 2016. During his tenure, he was First Vice-President of the Council, Vice-Chair of the AFI Plan, and Chair of ICAO Air Transport Committee. He was the AFI Group Coordinator.

Also, he was a Cameroon secondee to the Universal Safety Oversight Audit Program (USOAP), where he led the development and preparation of draft safety oversight reports as Air Navigation Services Expert. He audited States such as: Senegal, Central African Republic, Gabon, Democratic Republic of Congo, Sudan, Swaziland, Ethiopia, Rwanda, and Angola.

Mr. Zoa Etundi also served in the Civil Aviation Authority of Cameroon as Deputy Director of Air Navigation Services Safety Oversight (2001 – 2003), Deputy Inspector General for Air navigation Services, Training Center Coordinator (2003 -2008), and World Bank Regional Aviation Safety Expert (2004 – 2008). From October 2013 to October 2016, Mr. Zoa Etundi represented the Economic Community of Central Africa States (Angola, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, DR Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon and Sao Tome and Principe) as Regional Representative to the ICAO Council.
