The Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa (AFI Plan) was adopted by the 36th ICAO Assembly in 2007 (Assembly Resolution A36-1)

Focus Areas:

- Enable States to establish and maintain a sustainable safety oversight system;
- Assist States to resolve identified deficiencies within a reasonable time;
- Enhance aviation safety culture of African aviation service providers, through SMS implementation

AFI Plan Project Implementation – State Safety Programme (SSP)

29 Beneficiary States

Objectives:

- provide safety management training to Regulatory and Service provider staff involved in SSP/SMS implementation;
- assist eligible AFI States that have achieved an EI of 60% or greater to establish and implement an effective SSP
- assist States conduct SSP Gap Analysis and develop SSP implementation plans;

Outcomes:

 assistance missions already conducted in 11 States namely; Botswana, Cameroun, Cote d'Ivoire, Ethiopia, Gambia, Kenya, Mali, Mauritania, Togo, Zambia, Zimbabwe.



Safety Promotion AFI Plan - Fostering a Positive Safety Culture in Africa

Assistance and Capacity building

- Assistance to States to strengthen Safety oversight in Africa;
- Establishment of various projects including in the area of SSP/SMS;
- Capacity building (courses, seminars and workshops)
- Annual Aviation Safety Symposium (since 2014)
- Implementation of GASP and GANP (Regional Safety Targets and ANS Performance Indicators)

Awareness and outreach

- Communication and follow-up on the implementation of Abuja Safety Targets
- Meetings of the AFI Plan Steering Committee
- Meetings of the RASG-AFI and APIRG
- Safety annual reports (RASG-AFI)
- High level missions of ICAO (Engagement of States)
- Reports to the ICAO Council








Number of Accidents






Progress in the attainment of the Safety Targets - Resolution of SSCs







Effective Implementation by Audit Area (USOAP CMA) Status in Africa


