Mr. Moraes is the Superintendent of Flight Standards of the National Civil Aviation Agency (ANAC) since September 6, 2012. In his duties, he is responsible for the rulemaking, certification of operators, the licensing authority and for the safety oversight of air operations in Brazil. Prior to serving as the head of the Department of Flight Standards, he was the General Manager of Airline Transport Operations Certification Branch (GGTA) of ANAC, from July 2011 to August 2012. He is part of the civil public service since March 2010, as Civil Aviation Regulatory Specialist. Before joining the public administration, he worked for 18 years in the automotive industry, with attributions focused on industrial quality management and customer support.

Mr. Moraes is a Mechanical Engineer graduated from Mackenzie University, School of Engineering (1992), owning an Executive MBA from Instituto Mauá de Tecnologia (1999) and a specialization in Financial Administration and Controllership from Fundação Getúlio Vargas (2004). He holds a Commercial Pilot License for airplanes.
