# 2.4 **Document distribution**

2.4.1 The documentation distribution area is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Conference Centre. Each delegation of a Contracting State or an organization with observer status is entitled to a maximum of two sets of Conference documentation. If you have not submitted to the ICAO Secretariat the names of the delegates who shall receive hard copy documentation in their language of choice as requested in the process of pre-registration, instructions to that effect need to be given during on-site registration. Only those designated delegates with Conference badges flagging DOC and indicating their distribution box number will be handed their documentation at the documentation distribution counter. In order to avoid bottlenecks during rush hours at the distribution counter, delegations are encouraged to kindly coordinate among themselves how the papers will be collected for the entire delegation instead of individually. # 4. **PROCEEDINGS ON 23 NOVEMBER 2009**

## 4.1 **Opening session**

4.1.1 The Division was officially opened by the President of the Council, Mr. Roberto Kobeh González with an opening speech, and then addressed by an Air Transport Committee (ATC) Member, Mr. Daniel Ruhier, in the absence of the ATC Chair. The Director of the Air Transport Bureau (ATB), Ms. Folasade Odutola introduced the Division Secretary, Ms. Narjess Teyssier, Chief of the Economic Analyses and Databases Section, ATB, and other members of the Section, assisting the Secretary.

4.1.2 The Division adopted its agenda in WP/1 and noted the administrative arrangements of the meeting in WP/2.

4.1.3 The Division elected Mr. Serge Germon, Head of Secretariat General, Directorate General Civil Aviation, France as Chairman, Ms. C. Bertoni Lacerda Rodrigues, National Civil Aviation Agency, Brazil as the First Vice-Chairperson and Ms. R. Savithri, Director, Statistics, Directorate General of Civil Aviation, India, as the Second Vice-Chairperson. M. Germon began to chair the Meeting with a welcome note.

## 4.2 **Regular session**

4.2.1 Following an introduction by the Chairman of Agenda item 1 – Civil Aviation Statistics — ICAO Classification and Definition Issues, the Division considered this subject on the basis of the following working papers, listed in the order in which they were presented by the Secretariat: WP/3 — Scope of the ICAO Statistics Programme and Related Activities, WP/4 — Developments since the Ninth Session of the Statistics Division, WP/7 — Review of the Classification and Definitions used for Civil Aviation Activities, WP/5 — Available Capacity and Average Passenger Mass and WP/6 — Review of Definitions of Domestic and Cabotage Air Services.

4.2.2 Deliberations on Agenda item 2: Air Carrier Traffic Data and Traffic Flow Statistics started with an introduction by the Chairman. The Division started to consider these topics on the basis of WP/8 — Review of On-Flight Origin and Destination (OFOD) Publication Rules and Data.

4.2.3 A summary of the discussions will be reflected in the draft report, covering the aforementioned agenda items, to be considered by the Division on Wednesday, 25 November 2009 after lunch.

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
