Background

April 2010 deadline for MRPs

Obtaining official information on compliance status is difficult

Working Paper is based on the best information available at time of reporting

Current Status

- Small number of Member States are still issuing hand-written passports
 - Afghanistan, Algeria, Central African Republic, Equatorial Guinea, Kiribati, Libya, and Mauritania
 - Djibouti and DPRK issue MRPs for diplomatic and service only
 - Most appear to have plans or projects to introduce MRPs

Current Status (2)

ICBWG has identified a small number of states confirmed as having issues that affect, or may affect, the compliance status of their MRP

- Benin, Congo, Guinea-Bissau
- Iran and Tajikistan are resolved
- ICBWG undertaking further investigation into Laos, Guinea Conakry, East Timor, Somalia

Letters

The ICBWG, through the Secretariat, has corresponded with the five states drawing attention to compliance issues with their documents and offering assistance

To date, only Congo has responded to the Secretariat
