### Issue

Non machine readable passports in circulation after 24 Nov 2015 will no longer be compliant with Annex 9

Anecdotal evidence suggests there may be a large number of Member States affected by this deadline



Misconceptions about the requirement of Annex 9 in relation to ePassports – 24 Nov 2015 does not apply

### Implications

A large number of passports may not be accepted as valid if submitted when applying for visas, or when presented at borders

States may unnecessarily accelerate their introduction of ePassports



## **Proposed Way Forward**

## ICBWG will:

- Identify affected States
- Quantify the volume of travel documents impacted
- Develop options for issuing and receiving States
  - Draft a high level communication (State Letter) for approval and dissemination by the Secretariat, which will include clarification in relation to ePassports
