

Background

Significant time and resources has gone into the development of Doc 9303 specifications

Despite this investment States have no ability to fully test whether MRTDs comply





Proposal

ICAO shall offer a Doc 9303 Compliance Programme to Member States or vendors

Fee based programme shall be agreed upon by Member States

Scheme issues certificates of
compliance and non-compliance notices

Proposal (2)

ICAO shall own and manage the Doc 9303 Compliance Programme

 Use existing MRTD certification services offered by test authorities and individual experts (must be endorsed by ICBWG)
Initially limited to MRPs and eMRPS



Target Scenarios

Issuing authority or vendor that wishes to verify Doc 9303 compliance of an existing (e)MRTD

Issuing authority is going to market and wants the vendors to ensure Doc 9303 compliance and certification as part of the contract award and/or the delivery phase



ICAO – Administrator

Roles

Experts – Experience based analysis, particularly for evaluation of physical features (e.g. security)
