# PASSENGERNAMERECORD (PR)

Information about a person's travel reservation. It can be useful:

- For customs, law enforcement, security
- To help identify contraband, smuggling, etc
- To assist in risk assessment



# RACYADDAARCIECION

- PNR contains personal data
- Countries have different perspectives on how much is "private" or how much can be shared
- State to State agreement may be necessary
- Sensitive data should not be required
