Participants are requested to **register online by 11 January 2019**. Participants will be registered on a first-come, first-served basis. We encourage you to register for the seminar as soon as possible for planning purposes.

Participants will need to confirm their on-site registration prior to the seminar to collect their seminar badges which will be generated from the online registration. The registration desk will be available at the seminar venue Benin Royal Hotel on:

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

ECOWAS and UEMOA nationals can enter Benin freely, without a visa, with a passport or a valid national identity card. Visas can be obtained online on the website : <u>https://evisa.gouv.bj/fr/</u>

VACCINATIONS

A valid vaccination certificate against yellow fever is mandatory. However, passengers can get the yellow card and get vaccinated against yellow fever at the airport for a total amount of five thousand (5000) CFA francs, or $\in 8$.

Participants must also ensure that they have applied for valid health insurance for coverage of all medical care while in Benin.

In addition, participants are invited to send their flight plan to the Organizing Committee (addresses mentioned above) so that arrangements can be made to ensure the reception at Cotonou Airport and the transfer to the chosen hotel.

TRANSPORT

Transportation from the airport, hotel and training venue will be provided by the organizing committee. Special shuttles will be available.

Note : A shuttle bus will transport participants from recommended hotels to the seminar venue Benin Royal Hotel.

WEATHER SITUATION

The average temperatures are between 25 $^\circ$ C and 28 $^\circ$ C. But they can go up to 34 $^\circ$ C and go down to 22 $^\circ$ C.

USEFUL INFORMATION

TIME ZONE

Cotonou is one (01) hour ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC +1).

CURRENCY AND CREDIT CARDS

The currency used in Benin is FRANC CFA. All banking institutions in Benin have a foreign exchange office.

Banks are located in the arrival terminal and others not far from the seminar venue. They are open continuously from 8:00am to 04:00pm from Monday to Friday inclusive and for some banks on Saturday morning until 01:00pm. There are 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 200, 250 and 500 FCFA coins. Tickets are issued in denominations of 500, 1000, 2000, 5000 and 10,000 FCFA.

A fleet of taxis exists to do your shopping in town. Call "Bénin Taxi " on the green number 130 for your trips. The prices vary between 1000 FCFA (1.5 \in) and 5000 FCFA (8 \in) the race and according to the zone.

GEOGRAPHY

Located in West Africa, between Nigeria to the east and Togo to the west, Benin has 121 km of coastline with sandy beaches lined with coconut palms and has as neighbors to northern Niger and Burkina Faso. The territory extends in length over 700 km. Its area is 114.763 km² with a population of approximately 10,000,000 inhabitants.

LANGUAGES

There are more than one hundred (100) spoken dialects in Benin. The official language is French. Many Beninese also speak English, German, etc. The Fon and the Dendi are the 2 main national languages spoken fluently in the South and the North.

ELECTRICITY

French electrical outlets are those used in Benin. It is therefore necessary to provide adapters when your electrical outlets are different from the French ones.

Tips in Benin are generally not required. However, if you are a foreign guest with a good exchange rate and you can easily afford to be generous, people rendering special services will thank you.

In almost every restaurant and bar you can tip for the service and friendliness of the waiter or waitress.
