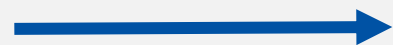

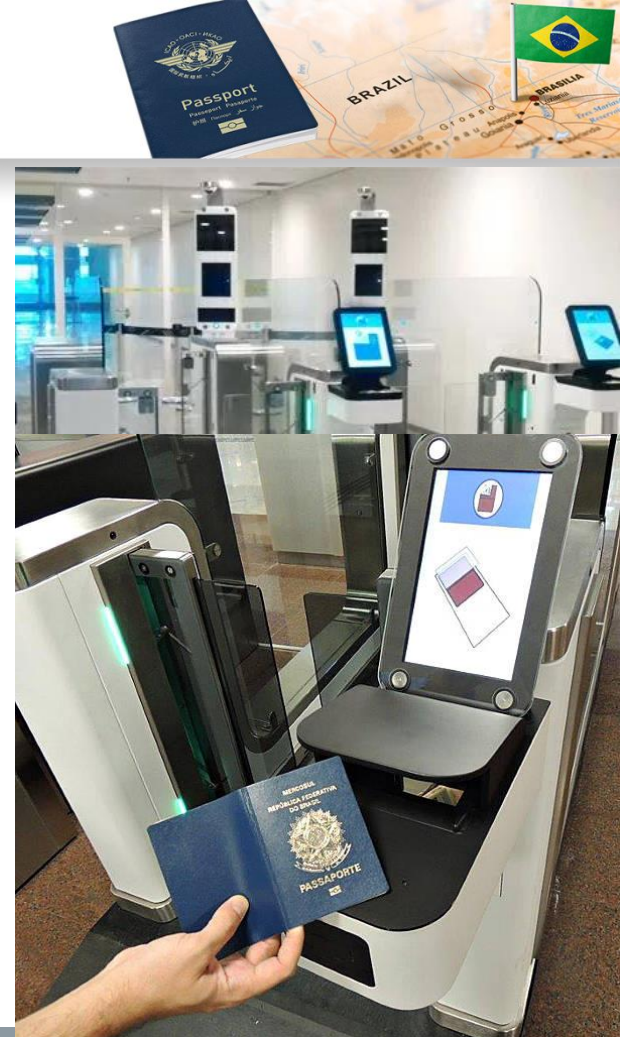
Guidelines for Travel Documents and Visas

- ✓ Prevent misuse, falsified documents;
- ✓ Promote security, efficiency and speed;
- ✓ Control over the preparation and dispatch of travel documents;
- ✓ Participation on ICAO PKD Program;
- ✓ Easy issuance of passports and visas;
- ✓ ICAO MRTD standards for passports and travel documents;
- ✓ Biometric standards in accordance with ICAO;
- ✓ 10 years / unlimited travel for Brazilian passport, except in special conditions (children, diplomats, officials);
- ✓ API/PNR – ICAO, WCO, IATA standards;
- ✓ Risk management of advanced passenger data due to facilitate the passenger flow.



Next steps

- ✓ Maintain the security standards of the Brazilian passport updated with the technologies available;
- ✓ Expand acceptance of foreign documents in Automated Border Controls (ABC);
- ✓ Extend the use of risk management over advance passenger information;
- ✓ Expand the Brazilian visa issue in electronic format;
- ✓ Update the National Identification Document to ICAO standard (9303);
- ✓ Expand the interoperability of airport technology, travel documents and authorities in order to facilitate the travel processes under a secure environment;





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
