MIGRATION INFORMATION AND DATA ANALYSIS SYSTEM










IOM in-house developed BMIS

- I. Affordable system to improve border facilitation and security: exit/entry.
- II. Collects, processes and stores traveler's information, including biometrics.
- III. Suitable for remote areas.
- IV. Governments have full and exclusive ownership of MIDAS' recorded traveler data.
- V. Operational in **19 countries** (Africa, South and Central America), 125 border crossing points (land, air or sea).
- VI. API integration (Belize).
- VII. E-visa integration: South Sudan
- VIII. Customizable and interoperable with e-platforms

- Biometric registration: photo and fingerprints
- Detection of duplications
- Automatic upload of applicants forms
- Manage the life cycle of the document, from the issuance till the end of its validity (Invalid/Lost/Stolen/Expired)
- Check previously registered passport or passport application (biometric validation face, fingerprints)




