Visitor eVisa

- **Countries:** Australia, Canada, the United States and Japan.

The four countries accounted for **63.74%** of the global demand for Brazilian tourist visas and **58.15%** of the global demand for Brazilian business visas in 2016 .

Law nº 13.445 / 2017: The new Brazilian Migration Law comes into force on November 21, 2017 introducing the Visitor Visa, which allows for **stays of up to 90 days per year** and **permits the realization of several unpaid activities** in Brazil, such as tourism, business, participation in conferences, workshops and transit.



Visitor eVisa

- **Definition:** a solution that allows the granting of visas in a short period of time, without the need to go to the Consulates, using only an electronic platform to fill out data and pay the fee.



Advantages of the new eVisa

- **Convenience:** The entire visa application process, payment of the credit card fee, analysis, granting and issuing of the visa is done online (via website or mobile app), without the need to go to Brazilian Consulates.
- **Cost:** The cost of the eVisa is lower than the traditional visa: USD40,00 + USD4,24 service fee.

It is always an option to apply for an ordinary printed visa, which continues to be issued at Brazilian Consulates.



Advantages of the new eVisa

It is important to highlight that the electronic visa is valid for up to 2 years or equivalent to the date of expiry of the applicant's passport.

- **Processing Time:** the entire process for granting the visa, from the submission of the visa application and payment of the fee until receiving the eVisa, is usually concluded within 5 working days.



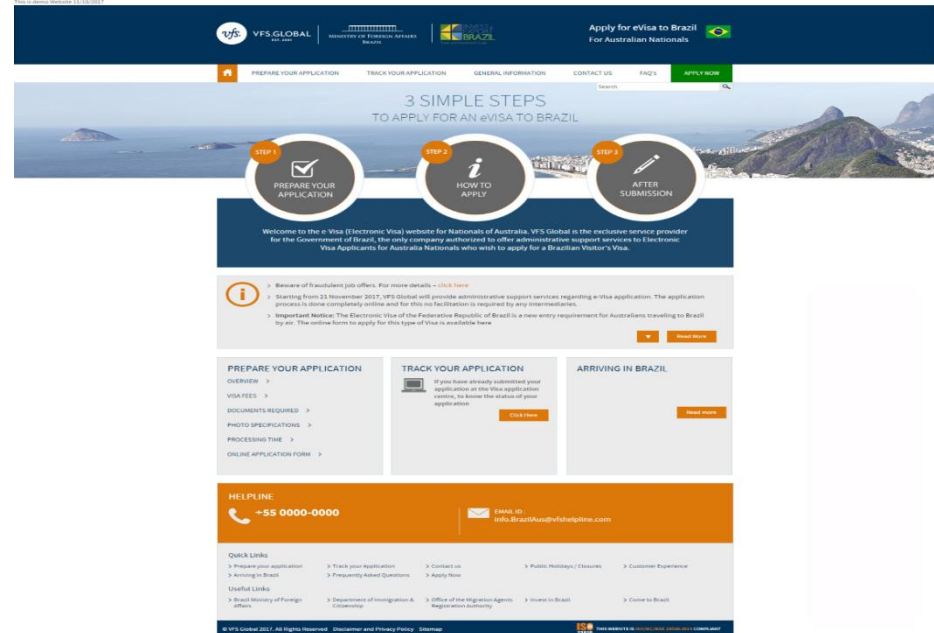
Advantages of the new eVisa

- **Security:** airlines and border authorities (Federal Police) have a wide range of tools to verify the authenticity of the visa.
- **Productivity:** The electronic visa allows the concentration of efforts and will speed up processing of other visas at Brazilian Consulates.



Steps to apply for the eVisa

- 1) Applicants have to visit the following website: www.vfsglobal.com/Brazil-eVisa/ or **app** to fill out the visa application form, upload the necessary documents and pay the fee with their credit cards;
- 2) VFS Global is linked to the Integrated Consular System (our consular network), responsible for the analysis and authorization of visas.
- 3) Brazilian consular officers analyse the application and authorize the issuance of the visa. Once this is done, VFS Global will deliver the visa;





Figures

(until 05/18/2018)

- **Australia:**

10,034 visas granted, since November 21st, 2017.

In April 2018, **97%** of the total amount of visitor visas issued to Australian citizens were electronic.

Comparatively a **52.23%** increase in the amount of visas issued for the same month in 2017.

- **Japan:**

3,429 visas granted, since January 11th, 2018.

In April 2018, **40%** of the total amount of visitor visas issued to Japanese citizens were electronic.

Comparatively a **25.04%** increase in the amount of visas issued for the same month in 2017.

- **Canada:**

5,552 visas granted, since January 18th, 2018.

In April 2018, **79%** of the total amount of visitor visas issued to Canadian citizens were electronic.

Comparatively a **74.55%** increase in the amount of visas issued for the same month in 2017.

- **United States:**

41,424 visas granted, since January 18th, 2018.

In April 2018, **74.56%** of the total amount of visitor visas issued to American citizens were electronic.

Comparatively a **44.17%** increase in the amount of visas issued for the same month in 2017.

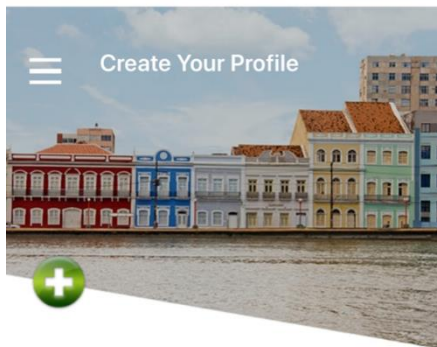

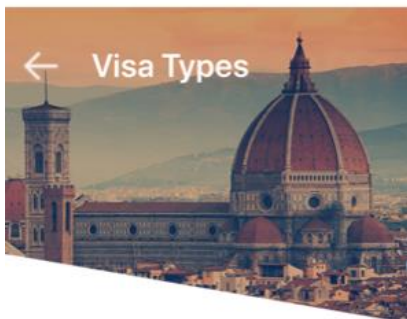

The user will have to upload the authorization letter once he is prompted to upload documents after he selects the parent or a legal guardian. These are the documents the parent 1/ parent 2/legal guardian has to upload

- Minor Authorization Form signed by both parents.
- Parent 1 ID
- Parent 2 ID
- If only 1 parent, supporting docs for why only 1 parent (e.g. authorization form for parent 2 stating parent 1, death certificate, birth certificate, single parent custody legal document etc.)

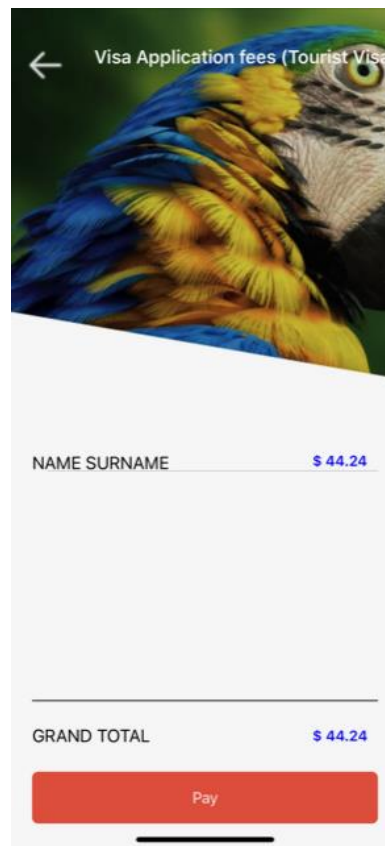

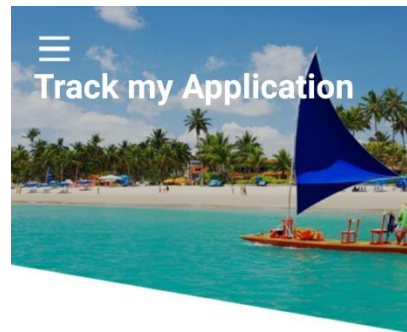

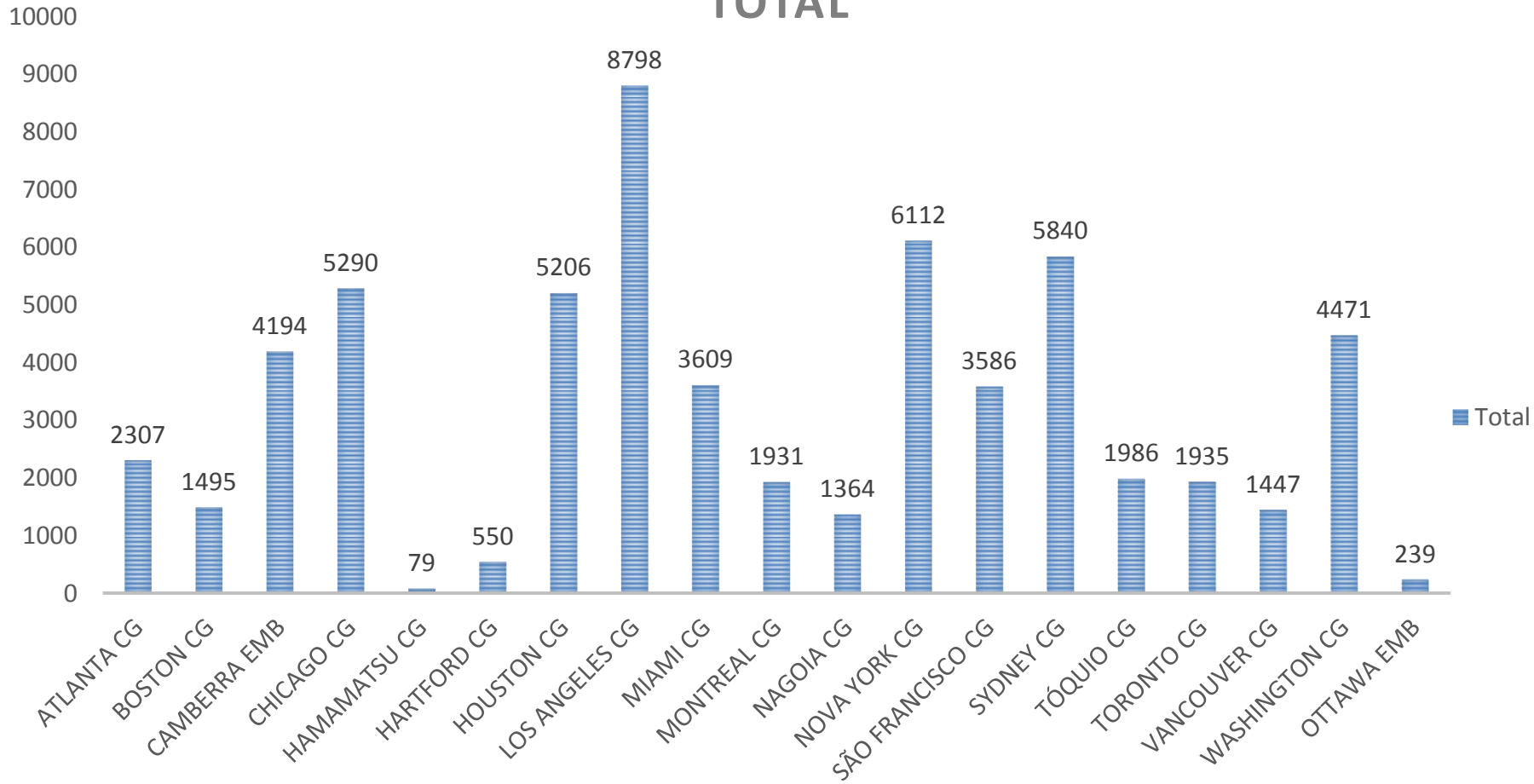

National from Australia, Canada, Japan and USA seeking admission to Brazil are required to obtain an electronic visa using this system prior to entrance to Brazil. If your eVisa application is approved, it establishes that you are eligible to travel, but does not guarantee that you are entitled to enter Brazil. Upon arrival to Brazil, you will be inspected by a Brazilian Immigration Officer, who may determine that you are inadmissible for any reasons under Brazilian law. All information provided by you or on your behalf, by a designated third party, must be true and accurate. An eVisa may be revoked at any time for any reason such as new information influencing eligibility. You may be subject to administrative or criminal penalties if you knowingly and willfully make a materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement on representation any.
