- One of the Association's advocacy themes is the issue of visa facilitation and the push for countries to either remove visa restrictions or enable e-visas. The ICAO TRIP Strategy strengthens traveller identification management and can allow destinations to reexamine their visa policies to encourage more international visitor arrivals.
