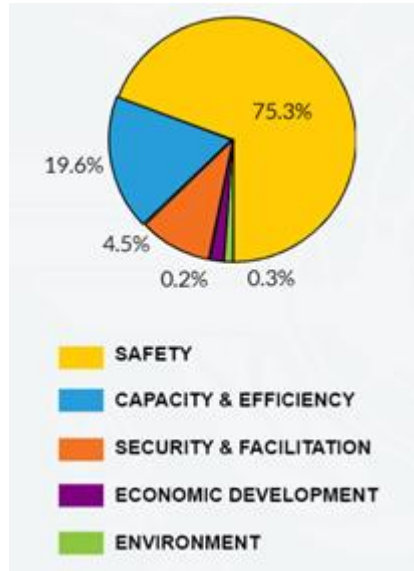

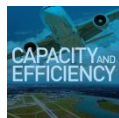

- The procurement of equipment and services of 322 POs







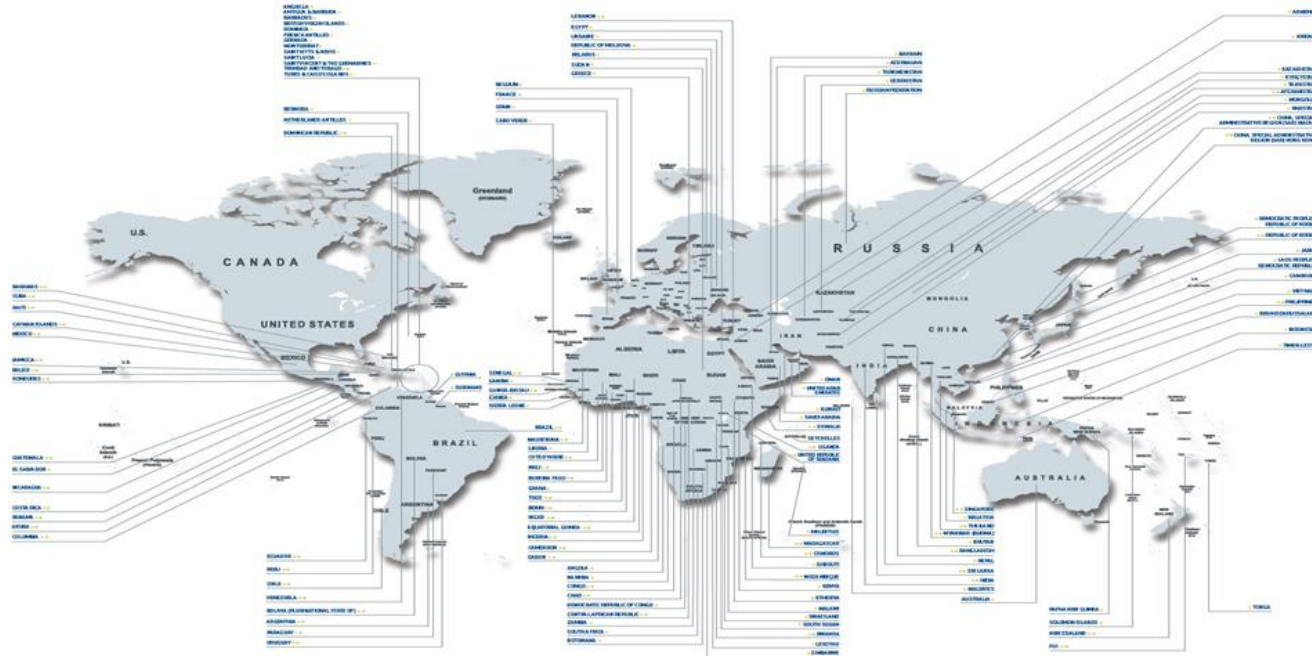
