

Passengers took to Twitter to bemoan delays in the early hours of this morning
In recent days families have felt compelled to arrive up to six hours before flight
Airports up and down the country have been struggling with staffing for months

Furious flyers shared pictures of huge passport control and security queues this morning as chaos continues to hit airports across Britain.

Passengers at Heathrow and Stansted bemoaned the substantial delays in the early hours, apparently due to a lack of staff on desks, while there was also disruption in Manchester.
