Yesterday's meetings

Fifth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Fifth Meeting, held on 27 September at 0900 hours, the Executive Committee considered Agenda Items 22 (*Human resources management*) and 23 (*Status of ICAO workforce*) on the basis of two working papers presented by the Council, WPs/75 and /76 (with information paper WP/226).

Under Agenda Item 24 (*Increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of ICAO*), it reviewed two additional working papers presented by the Council: WP/6 (Amendment of Rule 63 of the *Standing Rules of Procedure of the Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization* to include the use of the Chinese language); and WP/74 (Increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of ICAO – Improvements to information management). It also considered working papers WPs/227, 307 and 362 relating to language services.

The following issues were then discussed under Agenda Item 25 (Other high-level policy issues to be considered by the Executive Committee): Update of Assembly Resolution A22-4 (Composition of the Air Navigation Commission and participation in its work) documented in WP/24 presented by the Council; Formulation and implementation of Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) and Procedures for Air Navigation Services (PANS) and Notification of Differences, documented in WP/48 presented by the Council and WP/260; A Policy on assistance to aircraft accident victims and their families, documented in WP/22 presented by the Council, WP/301 (with Corrigendum No. 1) and information paper WP/300; Policy on third-party endorsements and Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) (WP/338) and Alignment of ICAO Strategic Objectives with Member States and a progress

reporting mechanism (WP/335).

The Executive Committee then commenced consideration of Agenda Item 16 (Facilitation and Machine Readable Travel Documents) on the basis of four working papers presented by the Council: WP/3 (Developments pertaining to Annex 9 – Facilitation and proposed work programme for the next triennium); WP/4 [Developments pertaining to the Machine Readable Travel Documents (MRTD) Programme and the Public Key Directory (PKD)]; WP/11 [Proposal for an ICAO Traveller Identification Programme (ICAO TRIP) Strategy]; and WP/23 (Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices relating to facilitation). At the time of adjournment, these working papers, and others relating to WP/11 (WP/94 Revision No. 1, 105, 161, 246, 254 and 267 and information papers WP/180, 269 and 322) had been presented and a number of comments made. It was agreed to resume consideration of this Agenda Item at the Executive Committee's next meeting, at which time Agenda Items 13 (Aviation Security – Policy), Agenda Item 14 [Universal Security Audit Programme (USAP)] and Agenda Item 15 (Aviation Security – Implementation Support) would also be discussed

Sixth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Sixth Meeting, held on 27 September at 1400 hours, the Executive Committee resumed and completed its consideration of Agenda Item 16 (Facilitation and Machine Readable Travel Documents).

It then considered Agenda Item 13 (*Aviation Security – Policy*) on the basis of two working papers presented by the Council: WP/12 [Outcomes of the High-level Conference on Aviation Security (HLCAS)]; and WP/13 [Declaration on Aviation Security and the ICAO Comprehensive Aviation Security Strategy (ICASS)]. The latter working paper was discussed in conjunction with related WPs/64, 128, 129, 133, 136, 138, 158, 172, 178, 197, 235 and 276 and information papers WPs/104, 124, 159, 273 and 345.

The Executive Committee next considered Agenda Item 14 [Universal Security Audit Programme (USAP)], documented in two working papers presented by the Council: WP/15 [with Revision No. 1 (French and Russian only)] [Universal Security Audit Programme (USAP): Transition to a Continuous Monitoring Approach]; and WP/16 [Universal Security Audit Programme (USAP)], with related WP/230 and information papers WPs/168 and 328.

Under Agenda Item 15 (Aviation Security – Implementation Support), the Executive Committee discussed three working papers presented by the Council: WP/20 (Aviation Security Assistance and Capacity Building Strategy); WP/21 [Implementation Support and Development – Security (ISD-SEC) Programme], with related WPs/107, 130 and 320 Revised and information papers WPs/152, 160, 217, 299 and 313 Revised; and WP/14 (Consolidated statement on the continuing ICAO policies related to the safeguarding of international civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference).

Second Meeting of the Technical Commission

The Technical Commission, at its second meeting on Friday, 27 September 2013, at 0900 hours, continued its discussion and completed its work on Agenda Item 28. The Technical Commission then considered and completed Item 29: Aviation Safety — Monitoring and Analysis. The Commission began its consideration of Agenda Item 30: Aviation Safety — Implementation Support.

Third Meeting of the Technical Commission

At its Third Meeting, on Friday afternoon, 27 September 2013, at 1400 hours, the Commission continued its discussion of and completed Agenda Item 30: Aviation Safety — Implementation Support as well as 31: Aviation Safety — Emerging Issues.

The fourth meeting of the Technical Commission will be held on Saturday, 28 September at 1400 hours in the Assembly Hall, 4th Floor. The fifth meeting will be held Monday, 30 September, at 0900 hours in the Assembly Hall.

Second Meeting of the Legal Commission

The Legal Commission, at its second meeting on Friday, 27 September, considered all the remaining agenda items.

Under Agenda Item 47, the Commission recommended that an Assembly Resolution be adopted to urge all ICAO Member States to sign and ratify the Montreal Convention of 1999. The Commission also agreed to include in the General Work Programme of the Legal Committee a new item entitled "Study of the Legal Issues relating to Remotely-Piloted Aircraft".

Please note that the second meeting of the Administrative Commission, previously scheduled for the afternoon of Wednesday, 2 October will be moved to Tuesday, 1 October at 0900 hours.

Conference Room 6, located on the third floor of the Conference Centre, will be used as overflow room with audio and video capability in the six official languages. For meetings in Conference Room 3 (first floor of the Conference Centre) one seat will be allotted to each Member State delegation (one at table). Please note that there are not enough seats to accommodate all Observer delegations in Conference Rooms 1, 2 and 3, due to the limited capacity of the rooms. Therefore, a maximum of one seat per Observer delegation may be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. One seat will be reserved at the front of the room (marked "Presenter") in order for Observer delegations to present their papers.
